Alphabet Scene

NUMBER OF PLAYERS: 2 or 3

OBJECT: Players play a scene (chosen at random) where one actor begins the scene with a letter from the alphabet (chosen at random). The next actor must begin their sentence with the next letter of the alphabet. The moderator chooses the starting letter.

EXAMPLE:

Scene at a birthday party.

Actor 1: (beginning with R) "Riley invited a lot of people."

Actor 2: "Sure hope we have enough food.

Actor 1 (or 3): "Thankfully there looks like there's enough ice."

Actor: "Ursula told me that she wasn't going to come because she's having her hair done."

Actor: "Vicky might be late because she's picking up the cake."

Continue until the scene ends with the last actor starting a sentence with the letter before the scene starting letter. (In this scenario it would be the letter Q.)
