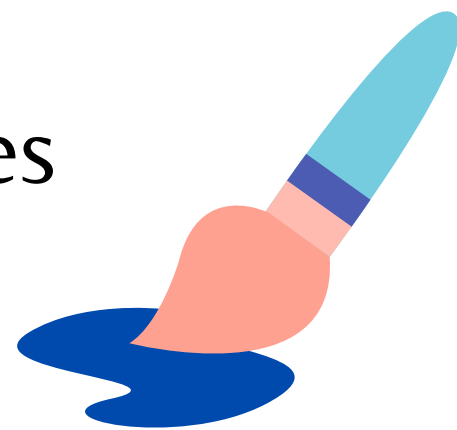


Connect the Dots - Triangles



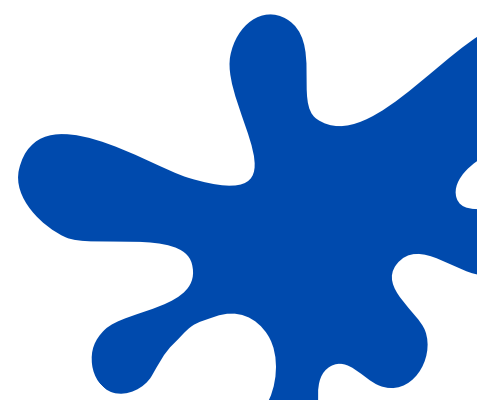
Supplies: computer or any white paper, regular and colored pencils or crayons, 12” straight ruler

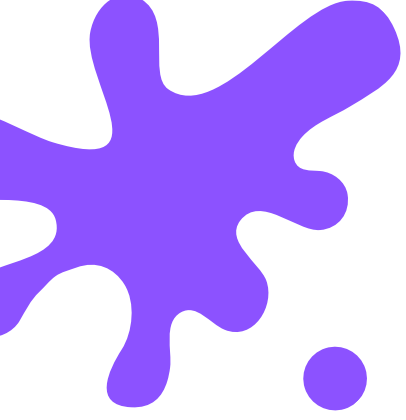
Have your students make about 21 random dots all around the paper (not too close together).

Using the straight ruler, connect sets of 3 dots to make triangles. Encourage them to overlap, make different sizes, and go in different directions.

If students want to create an easy focal point, have them make 3 triangles black and white, and the rest in different colors.

Using colored pencils or crayons, have the students color in the spaces with colors or stripes, dots, waves ...
