



Drawing an Adventure Grades K-5

Students will create drawings based on an imaginary vacation adventure. The adventure can take place away from home or around the neighborhood or even in the house. For example, each room in the house can become a different place for an adventure!

WHAT YOU NEED: Pencils Paper Color pencils or crayons or pastels or markers

Teacher Asks:

Ask students to imagine that they are going on an adventure.

Students then answer the following questions: "Where are you going on your adventure?" (A distant land, somewhere you've been before? a new place?)

"How will you get there?" (By car, plane, train, on foot, or via a new mode of transportation?)

> "Who will you see when you arrive?" (a friend? a family member? a creature? an alien?)



"What will you do on your adventure?"

Then, students will draw their adventures.
