# *Percussion Scavenger Hunt*

## **What You'll Need:**

- Any objects that you can either hit (wooden spoons, chopsticks, an empty bucket, plastic bowl, etc.), shake (box of crayons, bean bag, a bottle or can of nuts, baby rattle, etc.), or scrape (a pencil along the edge of a spiral-bound notebook, a metal water bottle with ridges).
- Access to YouTube, Spotify, Pandora or any music source

## **How It Works:**

- For a percussion scavenger hunt, all you have to do is have students find an object that you can hit, one that you can scrape, and one that you can shake.
- Once you find all of the "instruments", you can play along with a song of your choice.
