Rumble Ball

Supplies:

- A ball - Playground ball, tennis ball, bouncy ball, etc.
- Percussion instrument or body percussion

Activity:

- In this activity, you will be creating music based on the movement of a ball
- One person will be the Rumble Ball Master, moving the ball around
- Everyone else will be watching the ball and creating music around it
- When the ball bounces, everyone will hit their drum one time at the exact moment the ball hits the floor
- When the ball rolls, everyone will drum, drum, drum as fast as they can, or create a drum roll until it stops moving
- Once each person is able to follow along, feel free to create new movements and musical actions! And don't forget to give everyone a chance to be the Rumble Ball Master.
