



Unique Abstract Drawing

Grades: K-5



Students will be instructed to create unique works of abstract art.

WHAT YOU NEED:

Construction paper (light colors)

Markers- fine and thick tip (or you can substitute crayons, pencil crayons or pastels)

TEACHER:

Teacher/parent will call out directions for their students and children. Students will draw what they hear. Teacher/parent can use the following directions or they can make up their own:

For Younger Students:

Draw four straight lines from one edge of your paper to the other.

Draw five circles anywhere on your paper.

Draw one curved line that starts at one edge of your paper and ends up somewhere in the middle of your paper.

Color in two of the circles — any color you like.

Fill in three areas of your paper however you like (completely colored in, lines, squiggles etc.)
