

Unique Abstract Drawing Grades: K-5



For Older Students:

Draw four straight lines from one edge of your paper to the other.

Draw two more straight lines from one edge of your paper to the other and make the lines cross over the lines you have already drawn.

Draw five circles – any size – anywhere on your paper.

Draw two curved lines beginning at the edge of the paper and ending up somewhere in the middle of the paper.

Fill in three of the five circles. Fill in four areas of your paper however you would like.

Once the drawings are complete, students should sign their work.

The work should be put on display in the classroom and a discussion should take place.

Do the drawings look the same? Different? How are they similar? How are they different? Why?

Come up with as many different sets of directions as you can. You will be amazed at the

unique qualities of all of the drawings.
