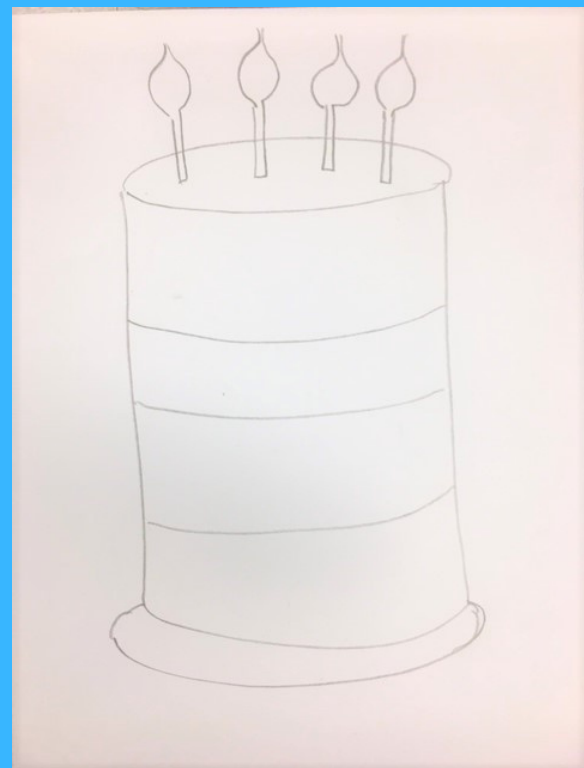
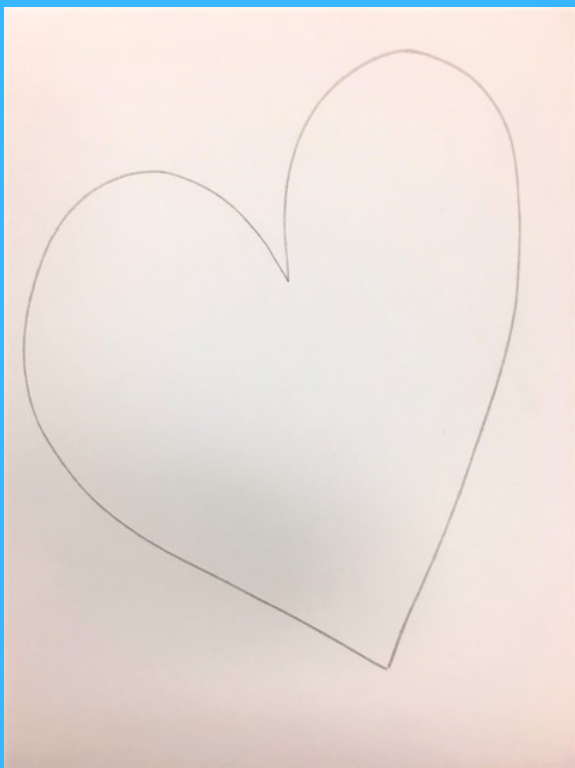
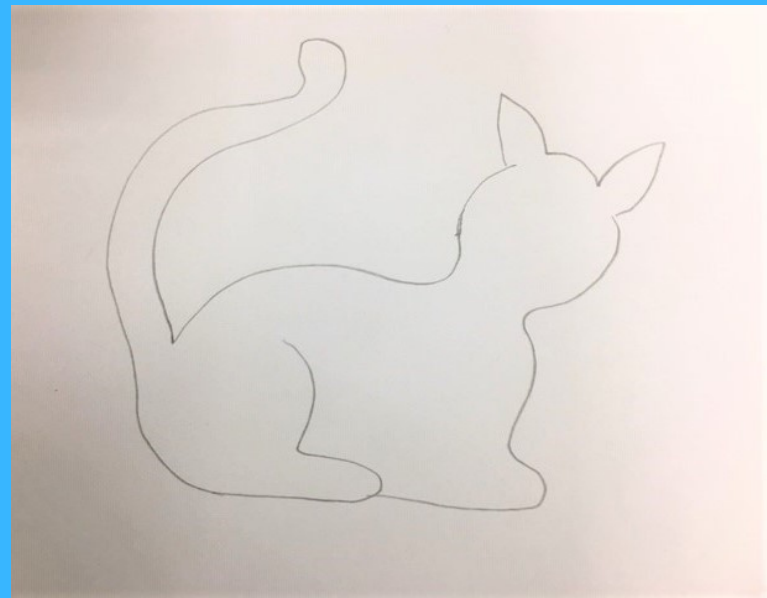
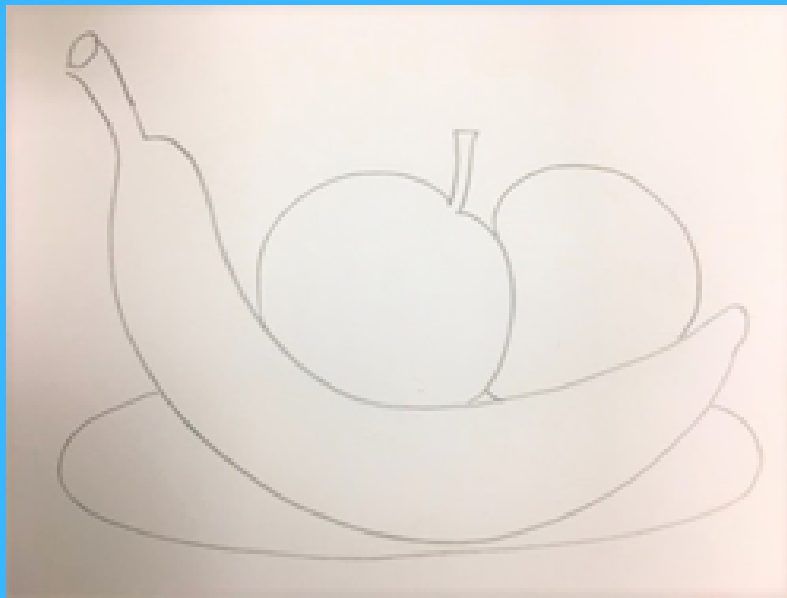


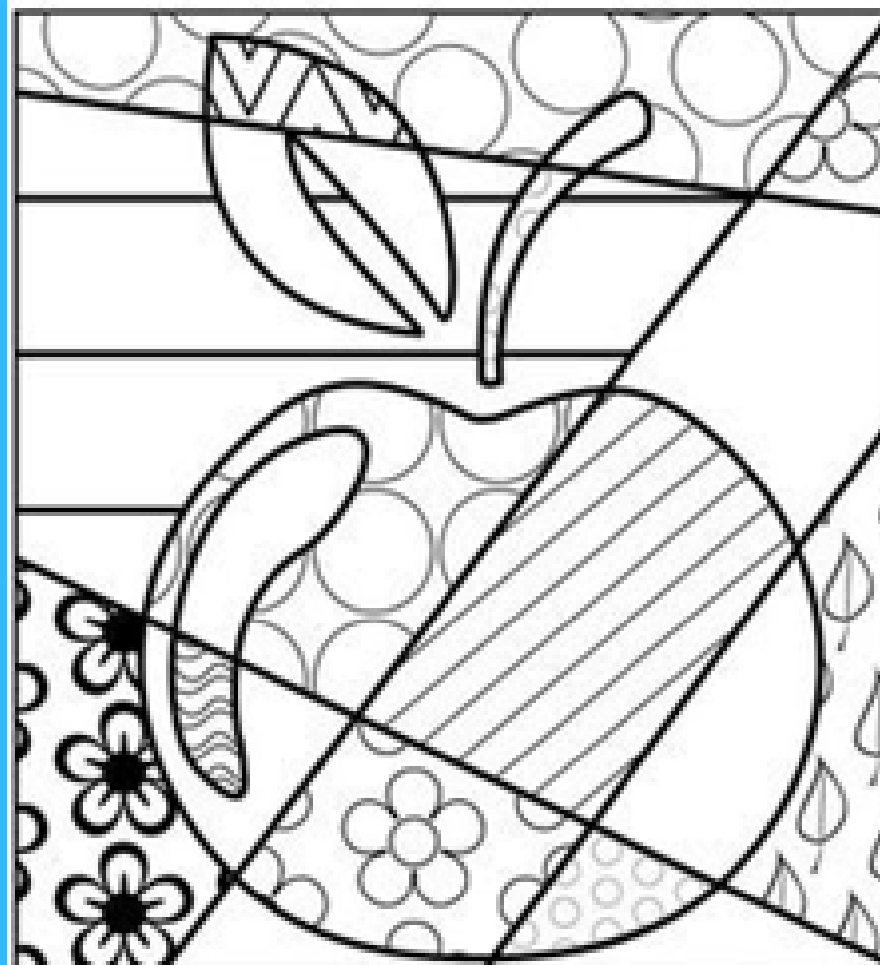
Create Your Own Coloring Pages

Supplies: White paper, pencil, black sharpie, ruler, colored pencils, crayons or markers.

Instructions: Draw a simple outline of something filling most of the space on white paper.
(like an apple, heart or just a shape you like)



Go over your picture with a black sharpie



With a ruler, pencil, or black sharpie, draw straight lines across the page in different directions and places like the examples below.

With pencil or black sharpie, make up your own designs to fill in some of the spaces. It is okay to leave some plain.

If you have a copying printer, make black and white copies of your coloring page and share with others or have fun coloring them with different colors.
