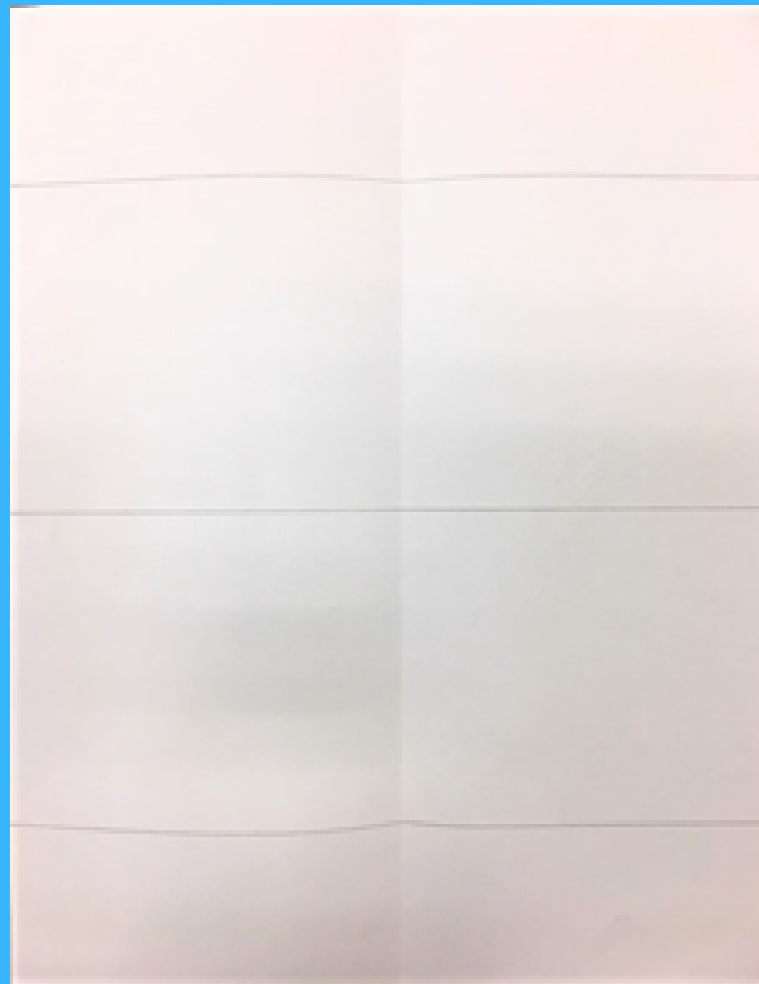


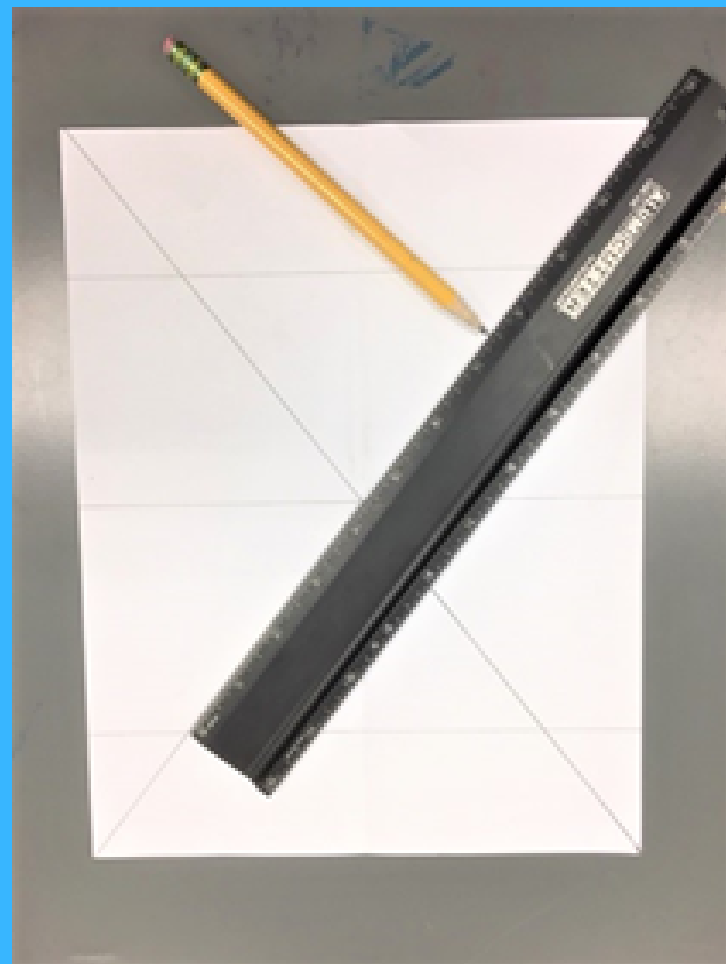
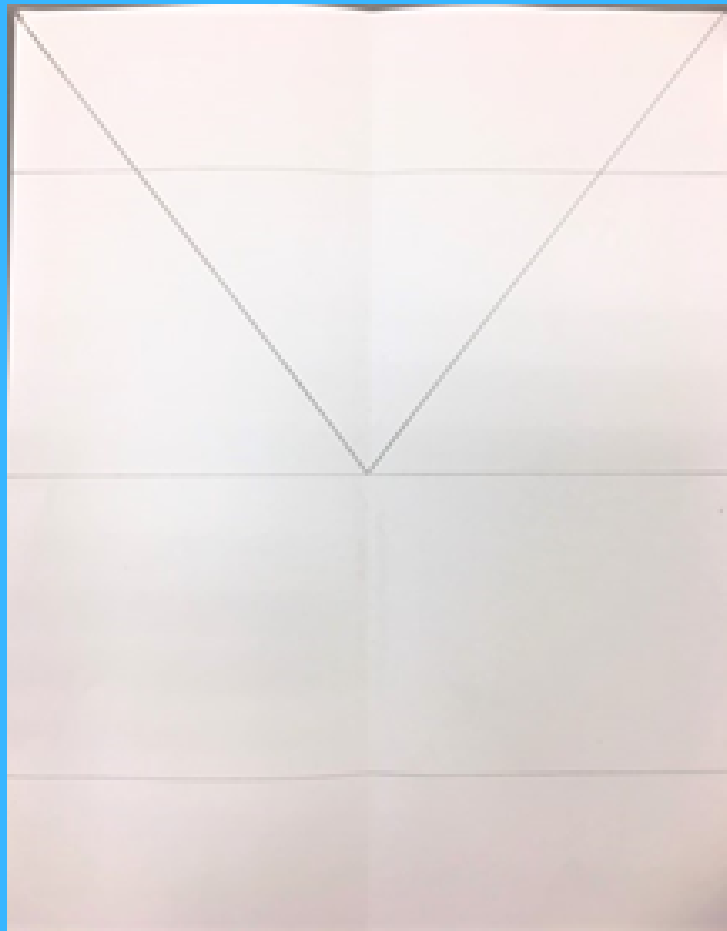
Fun with Lines (Good for Teens)

Supplies: Regular white computer paper, markers or colored pencils (even crayons work), a ruler, and pencil

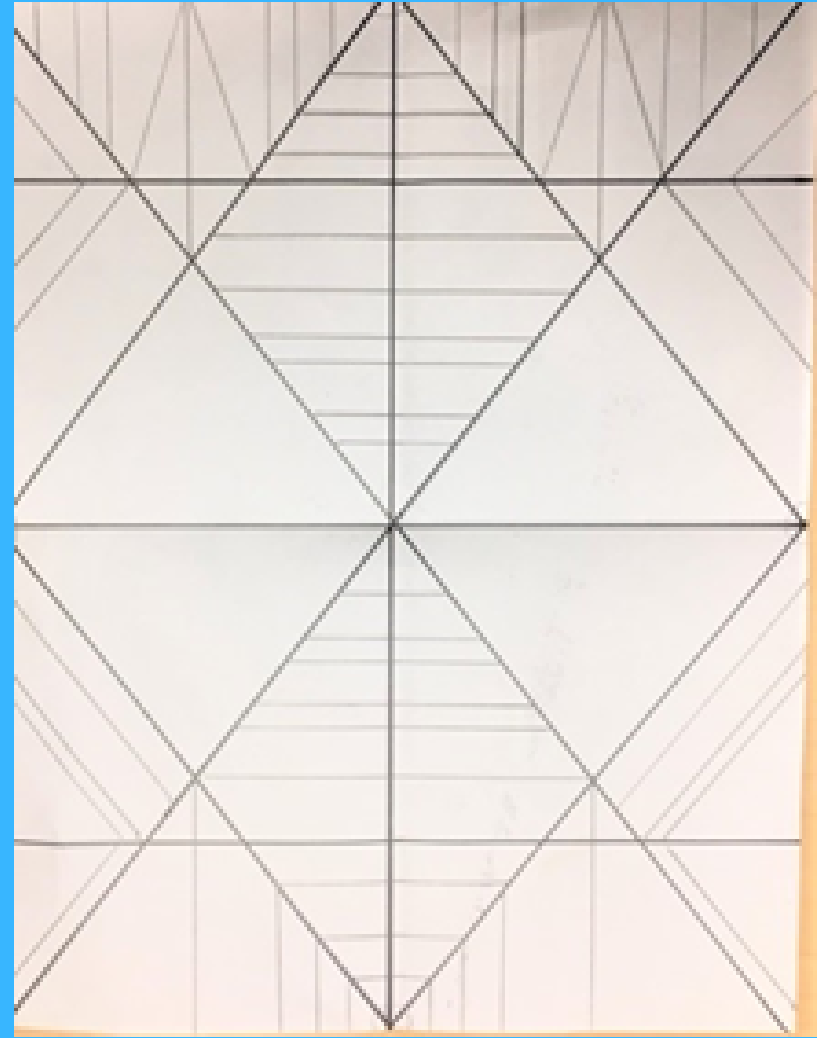
Have your students fold the paper in half in both directions, then place 1 horizontal (side to side) line on their paper across the center and one above and one below using the ruler and pencil.



Have students place 2 diagonal lines going from the center of the paper to each corner on the bottom then 2 diagonal lines going from the center of the paper to the other two corners

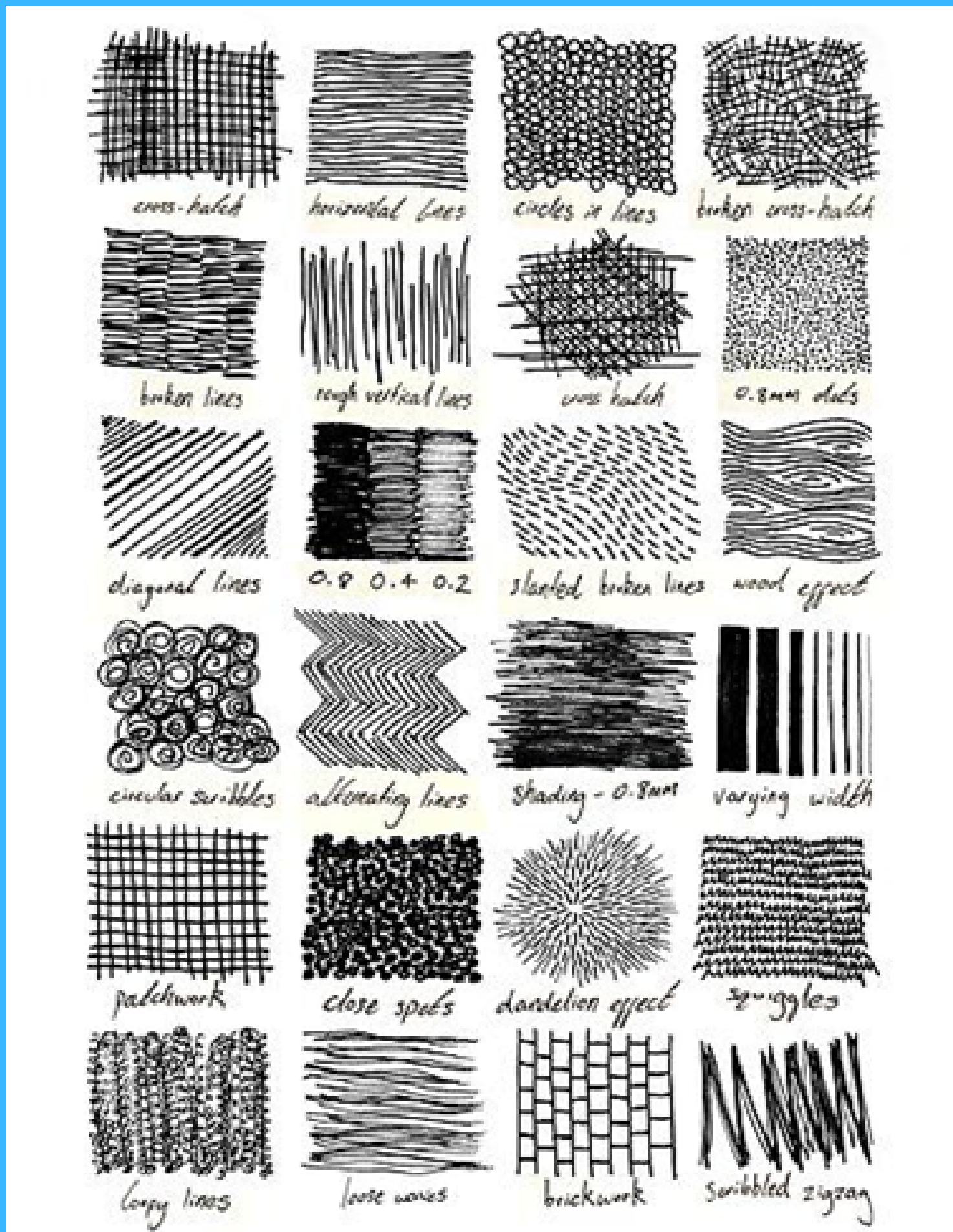


Then, students will line up the ruler diagonally from the center top to the center sides and from the center bottom to the center sides to form a diamond shape



Students should now carefully use the ruler go over all the lines with a black sharpie or black colored pencil.

Now you can add your own lines and spaces to the basic design



Lastly, color in sections with different colors and types of marks.

The sample is not meant to be the only results your students may get. If the spacing of the lines is different that is entirely okay. There is no need to get so detailed but it can be fun and takes more time to add details like the sample below. To get the best results, have students put it away and work on it as many days as it takes without frustration or burn out until complete.
