Draw a Cartoon Cat Grades K-12

Students will create a drawing of a cartoon cat.

WHAT YOU NEED:


Pencils

Paper

Colored pencils or crayons or pastels or markers


TEACHER ASKS:

Students if they have a cat or know someone who has a cat.




Step 1

start by drawing an oval shape for the head. It can be boxy, more circle like or even a slightly triangular one.



Step 2

Time to start making a few triangles. Draw two triangle shapes for the ears and one triangle shape for the nose. You could also make the nose oval or round.



Step 3


Let's make the cat face! Draw two smaller triangle shaped lines inside the eras. Make two spots for eyes. Next lets make the mouth. Start by drawing short straight line from the bottom of the nose downwards. Starting next to this line (on the left) draw the mouth curve, bring it down and up again to meet the line you made under the nose. Continue with another curve.



Step 4


Draw whiskers.

Also start drawing the body. Draw two curved lines, one on the left side and one one the right.



Step 5

Draw feet. Start with the front ones (long U shape). Hind legs are optional, but I do think they can complement the picture.



Step 6

Almost done! Just a few more details left. Like claws, the line that completes the belly and a tail.

Congratulations! You have just learned how to draw a cat.
