

Dream T-Shirts - Grades 5-12

Dream T-Shirts

What are your goals? Students design their dreams on a T-shirt!



SUPPLIES NEEDED

Colored Pencils

Construction Paper

Pointed Tip Scissors

String

Washable Markers

Directions

1. Students discuss with their classmates where they have traveled or would like to go-perhaps to the moon or snorkeling under the ocean. Students choose something important to illustrate on a T-shirt.
2. On a large piece of paper, outline a T-shirt with Crayola® Colored Pencils. Use Crayola Scissors to cut it out. If desired, students can make two shirts so they can design both the front and back.
3. On the T-shirt, students sketch a scene from their vacation, a place they would like to visit, a person they would like to meet, or another dream.
4. With Crayola Washable Markers, color the designs. Print the name of the destination or person, or write a motto to fit the dream.
5. Students present their T-shirt designs to the class. Explain what it illustrates and why they chose this place, person, or goal for their T-shirt?
6. To display, hang the shirts like laundry on a long string.
