

## Dancing Dice 2 – Grades K-12

Needed material: Dice, white board or piece of paper, pen or dry eraser & marker

Instructions: Get a huge dice (or you can make one), and 6 students will be chosen to pick a song and dance they'd like to do. Write a list numbered 1-6 with the song and dance moves and each number on the dice will correspond with the list of songs and dance moves chosen by the students.

If there are more than 6 students participating, a few rounds of this game will have to be played so that every student will have a chance to choose a song and dance. Once moves and songs have been chosen, it's time to roll the dice. Choose a student to roll the dice and whatever number it lands on will be the song & dance that's done. Throughout the song, students will practice doing that move in different ways (it's also okay to let them freestyle after trying the move for the first part of the song). This activity could get lengthy so for the sake of time and allowing everyone an opportunity, you do not need to play the entire song. Enjoy!
