
Draw a Clownfish - Grades 5-12




This drawing teaches students how to draw a fish using curved lines. You may want to lightly draw vertical and horizontal guidelines. Students begin with pencil then progress to color.


Materials: Paper, Pencils, Crayons, Watercolor, Pastels


Let's use a little geometry to draw a Clownfish, step by step.

We will start with learning about the curve. What is a curve? The curve is a rounded line or surface which is not flat




- 1. Start the fish body. Make a curved top and curved bottom.
- 2. Finish the body with the tail.







3. Draw the fish a face. You can make the face any way that you want.




4. Add the wavy center stripe.




5. Add stripes to the tail.




6. Draw the fins in between the stripes.



8. Add bubbles to the background.



7. Add the side fin.



9. Trace with a marker, pencil or crayon and color.
