
Draw a Rose (Advanced) - Grades 9-12




This drawing teaches students how to draw a rose using curved lines. Students begin with pencil then progress to color.


Materials: Paper, Pencils, Crayons, Watercolor, Pastels

Let's use a little geometry to draw a rose, step by step.

We will start with learning about the curve. What is a curve? The curve is a rounded line or surface which is not flat




1. Let's begin by drawing a small coffee bean. This is going to be the center of the rose.




2. Next we're going to add a spiral outside of the bean.



3. Draw two squiggly lines next to the spiral. These lines will create some of the petals of the rose.




4. These three lines shape the center of the rose.




5. Two leave like pieces will complete the bud of our rose.



6. Draw the outside petals making simple curves.



7. These two leaves are the base of your rose. Drawing a noodle will make the stem.



8. Adding a couple of leaves will finish your lovely rose!



9. Finished! Color your rose!
