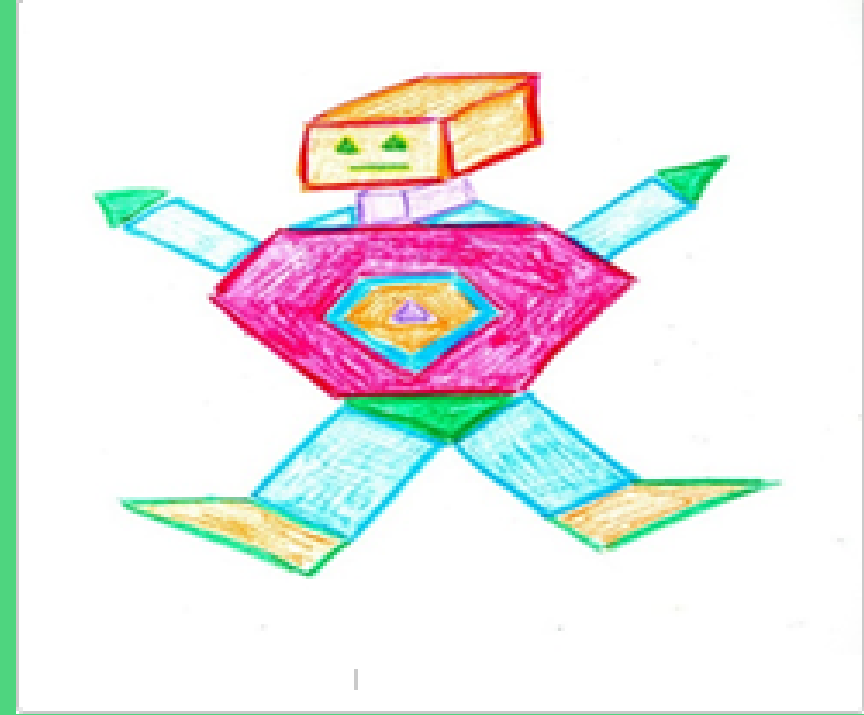


Geometric Character – Grades 2-4



Design a character using geometric shapes. Use Crayola® Dry-Erase Crayons for a no mess, temporary product!

Students review the identifying traits of the following geometric shapes: triangles, quadrilaterals, pentagons, hexagons, and cubes.

Give students individual white boards, or a space on a classroom white board. Photo paper or white plastic plates can be substituted for white boards.

Provide students with Dry-Erase Crayons.

Ask the students to draw a character using only the following geometric shapes: triangles, quadrilaterals, pentagons, hexagons, and cubes. Remind them that if they make errors, they can easily be erased and changed.

Ask the students to find a partner and take turns identifying the geometric shapes they find in each other's characters.
