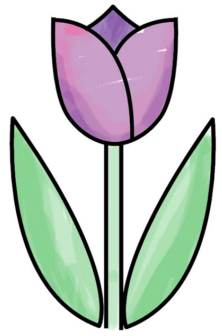


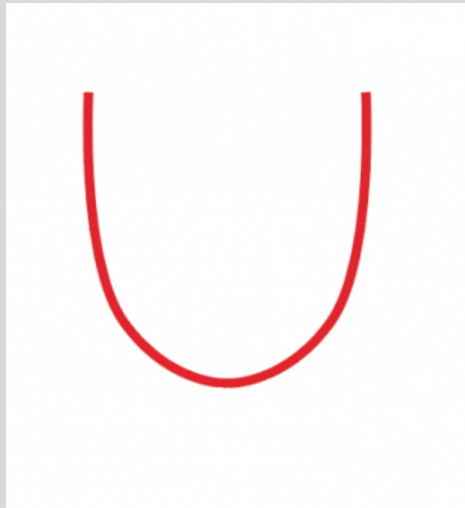
# Draw a Tulip - Grades K-12



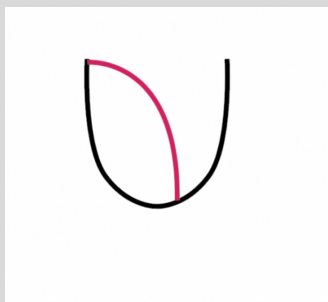
**This drawing teaches students how to draw a Tulip using curved lines.**

**Materials: Markers, Paper, Pencils, Crayons, Watercolor, Pastels**

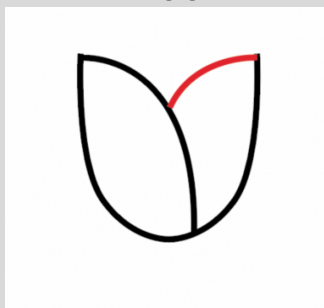
**Step 1: Draw a U shape.**



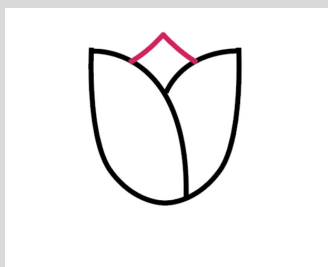
**Step 2:** Draw a curved line. Start at the top (left or right) and draw the line, bringing it to the bottom of the U shape.



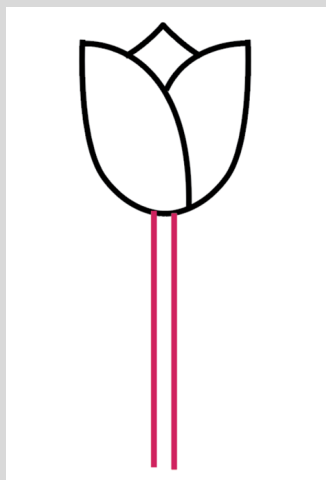
**Step 3:** Now draw a curved line from the other side. There are many ways you can end the line – it can touch the line from the previous step, or by it touching the U shape. All is OK.



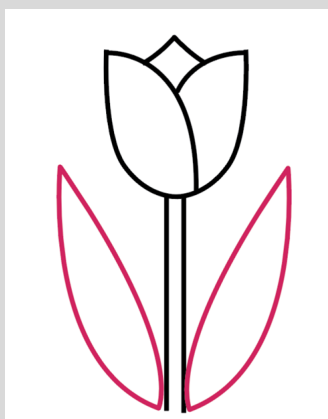
**Step 4:** Draw the last part of the tulip blossom.



**Step 5:** Draw the stem. Two straight lines from top to bottom.



**Step 6:** Finish up your tulip by drawing a leaf or two.



**Step 7:** Tulips come in many different colors. So, feel free to color your tulip any color you want.
