
Draw a Tulip - Grades K-12



This drawing teaches students how to draw a Tulip using curved lines.

Materials: Markers, Paper, Pencils, Crayons, Watercolor, Pastels


Step 1: Draw a U shape.




Step 2: Draw a curved line. Start at the top (left or right) and draw the line, other side. There are many ways you can end bringing it to the bottom of the U shape.


Step 3: Now draw a curved line from the other side. There are many ways you can end the line – it can touch the line from the previous step, or by it touching the U shape.





Step 4: Draw the last part of the Step 5: Draw the stem. Two straight lines from tulip blossom. top to bottom.





Step 6: Finish up your tulip by drawing a leaf or two.

Step 7: Tulips come in many different colors.
