2-Practice zig zags by drawing straight lines from number 1 (in order) to the last number.

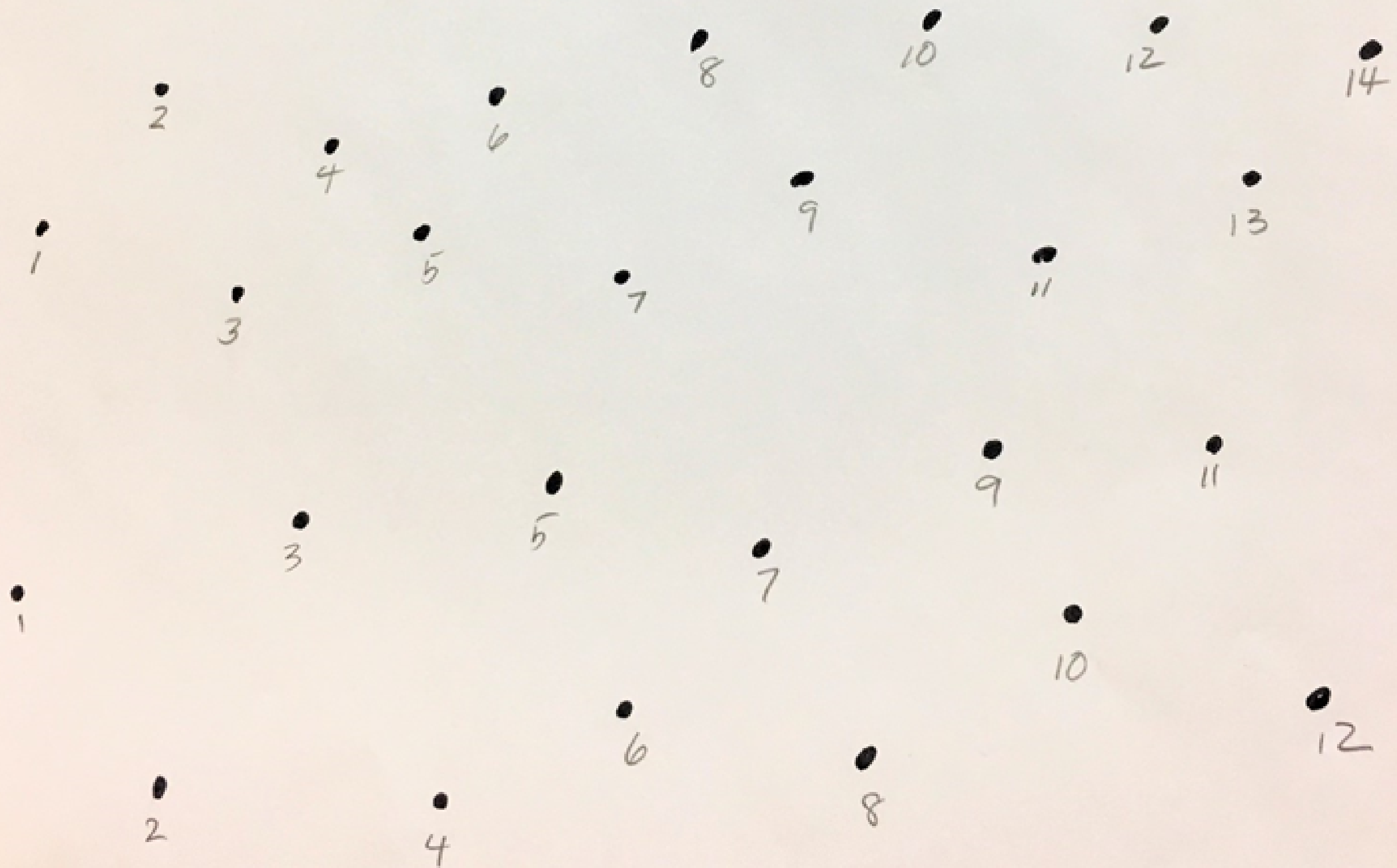
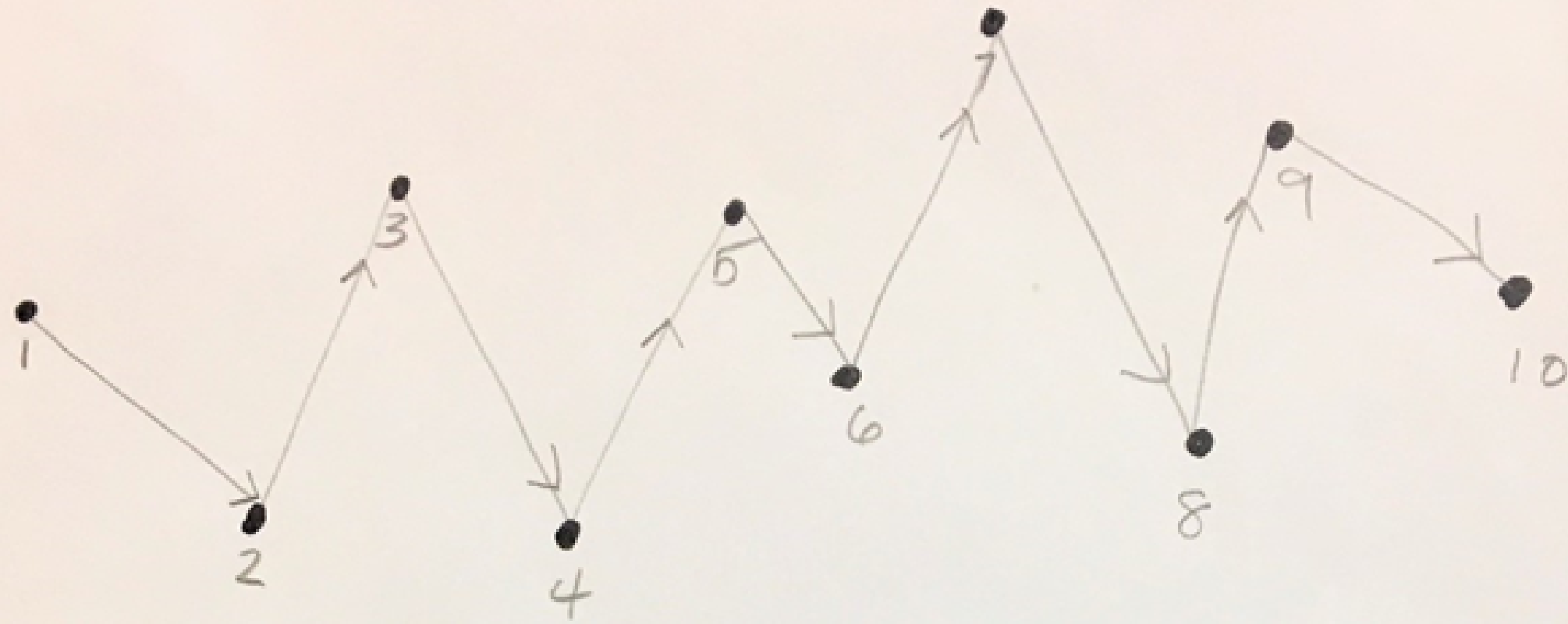
3-Look at my example of a Zig Zag Abstract on page 3. I drew an abstract landscape- mountains and lightning bolts with black marker and colored in with crayons.

4-On a piece of white paper create your own design with zig zag lines.

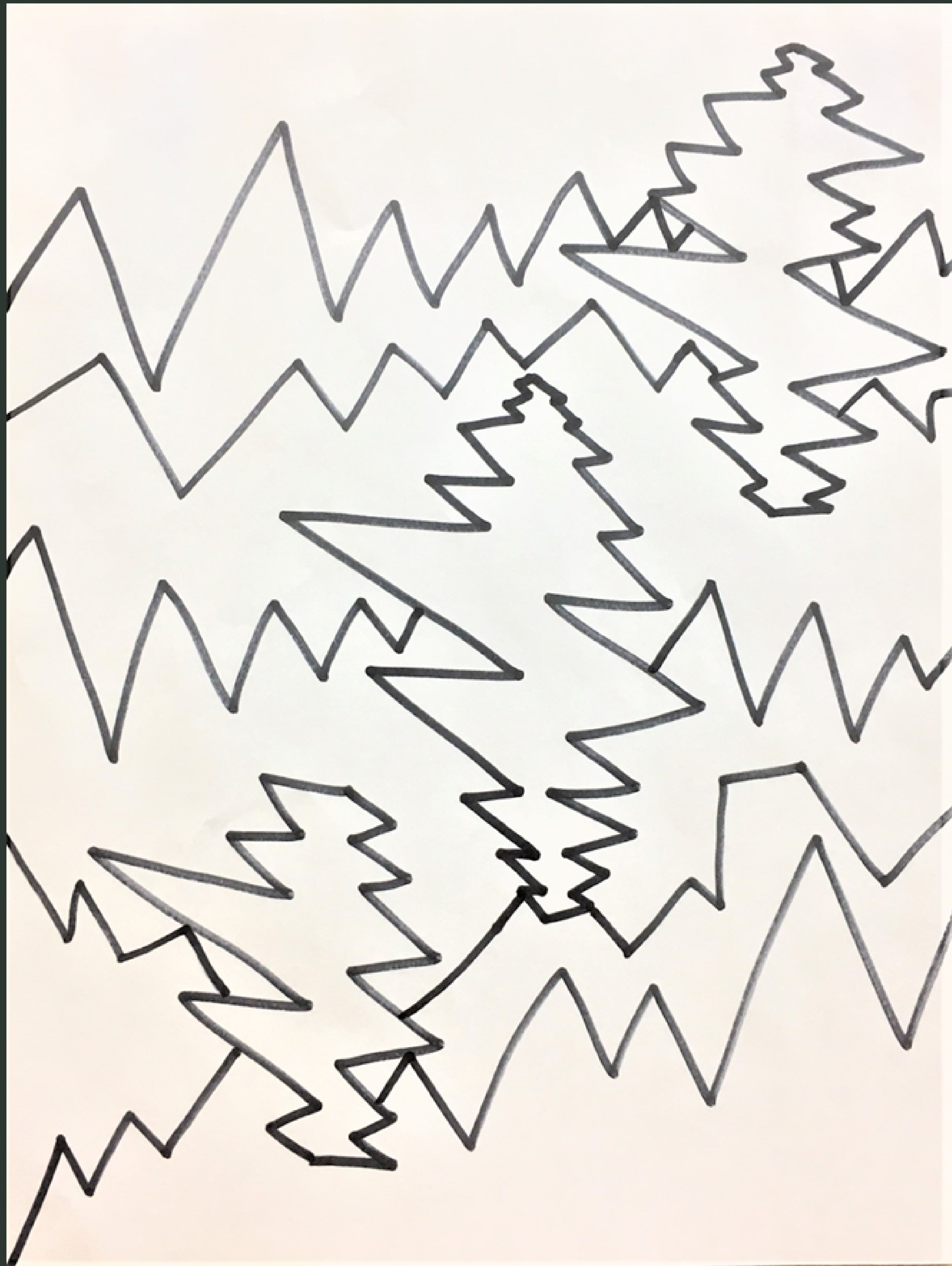
5-Color in your design with whatever media you have to work with

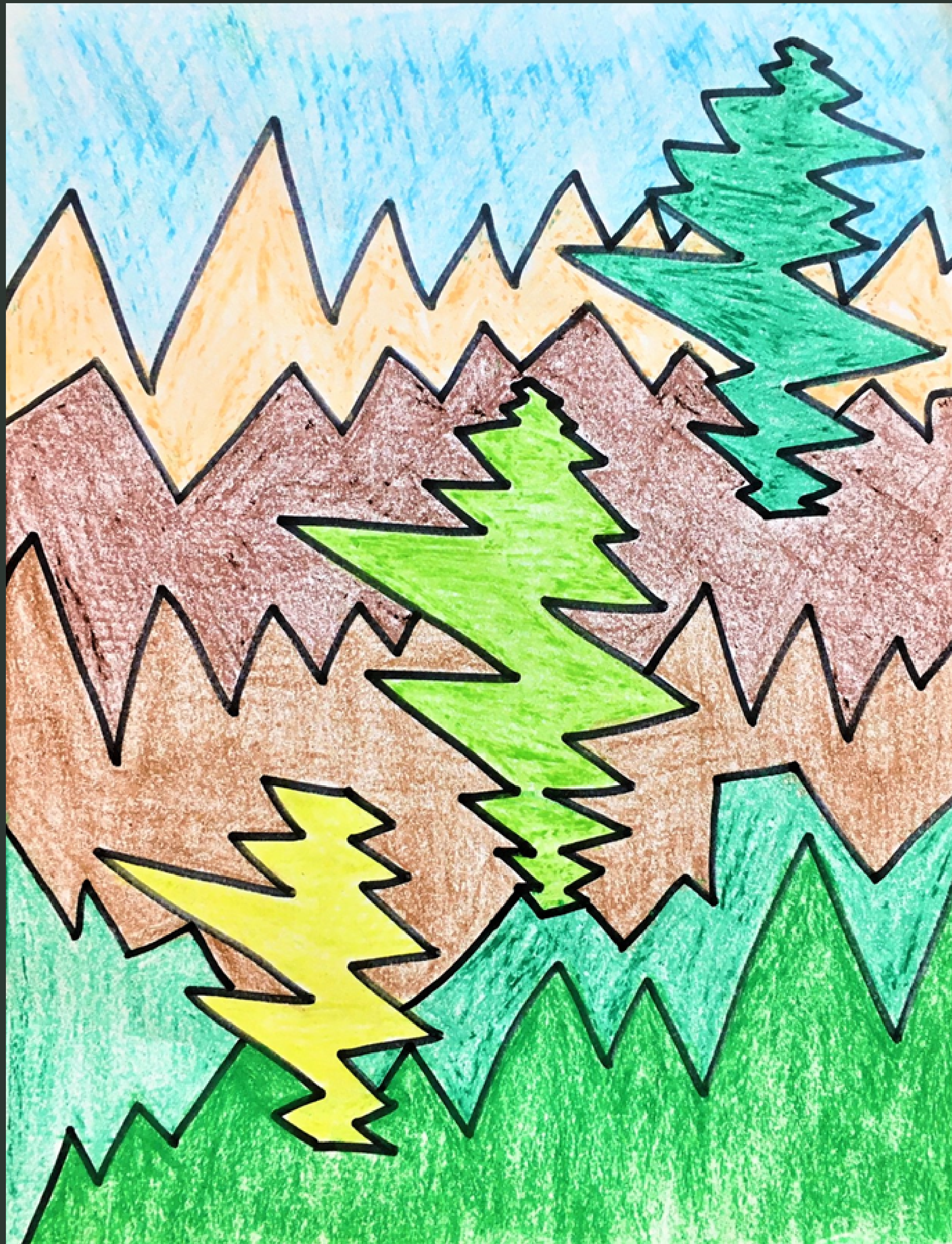
