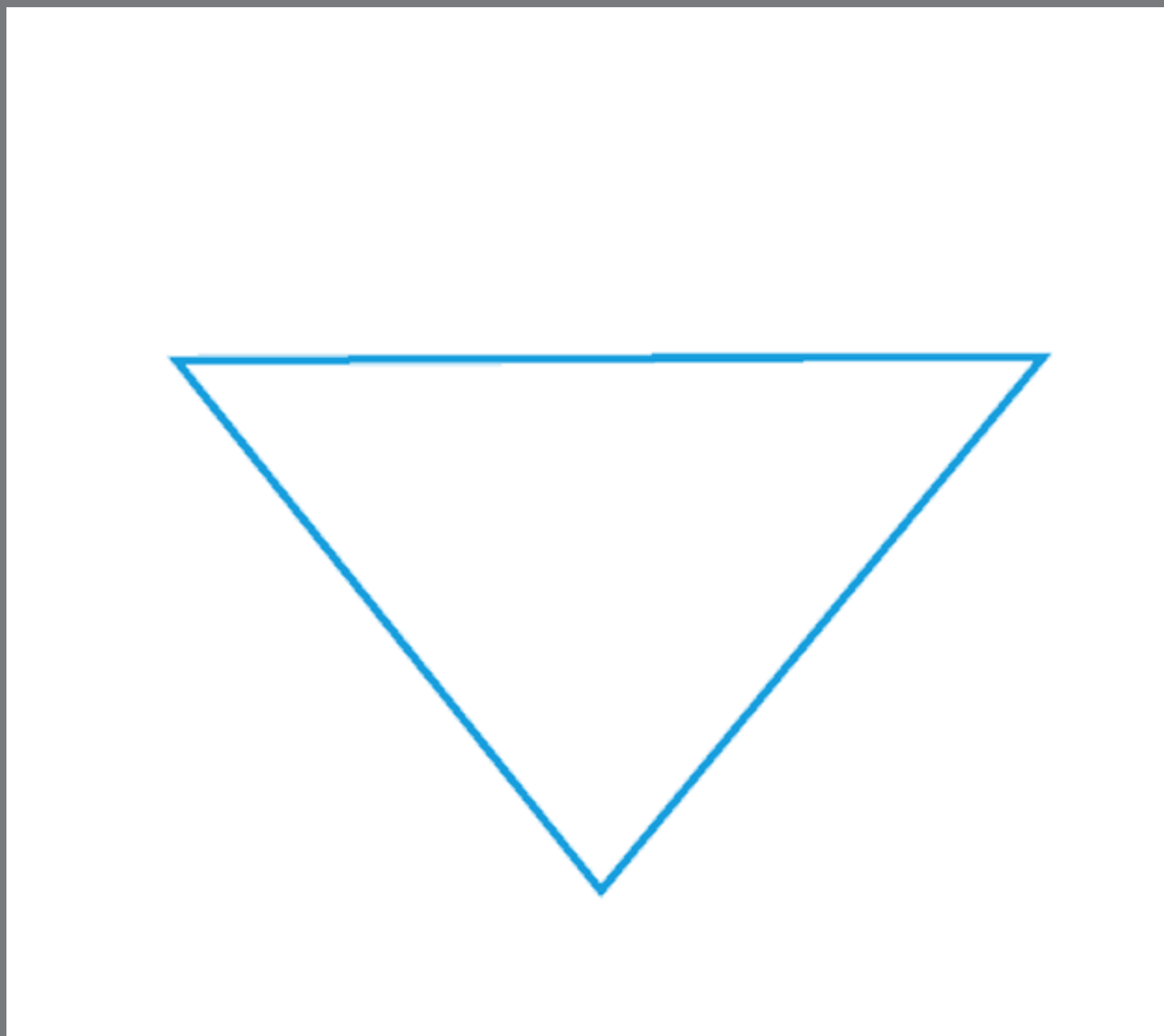
Compassion Heart

If you describe someone or something as compassionate, you mean that they feel or show pity, sympathy, and understanding for people who are suffering.

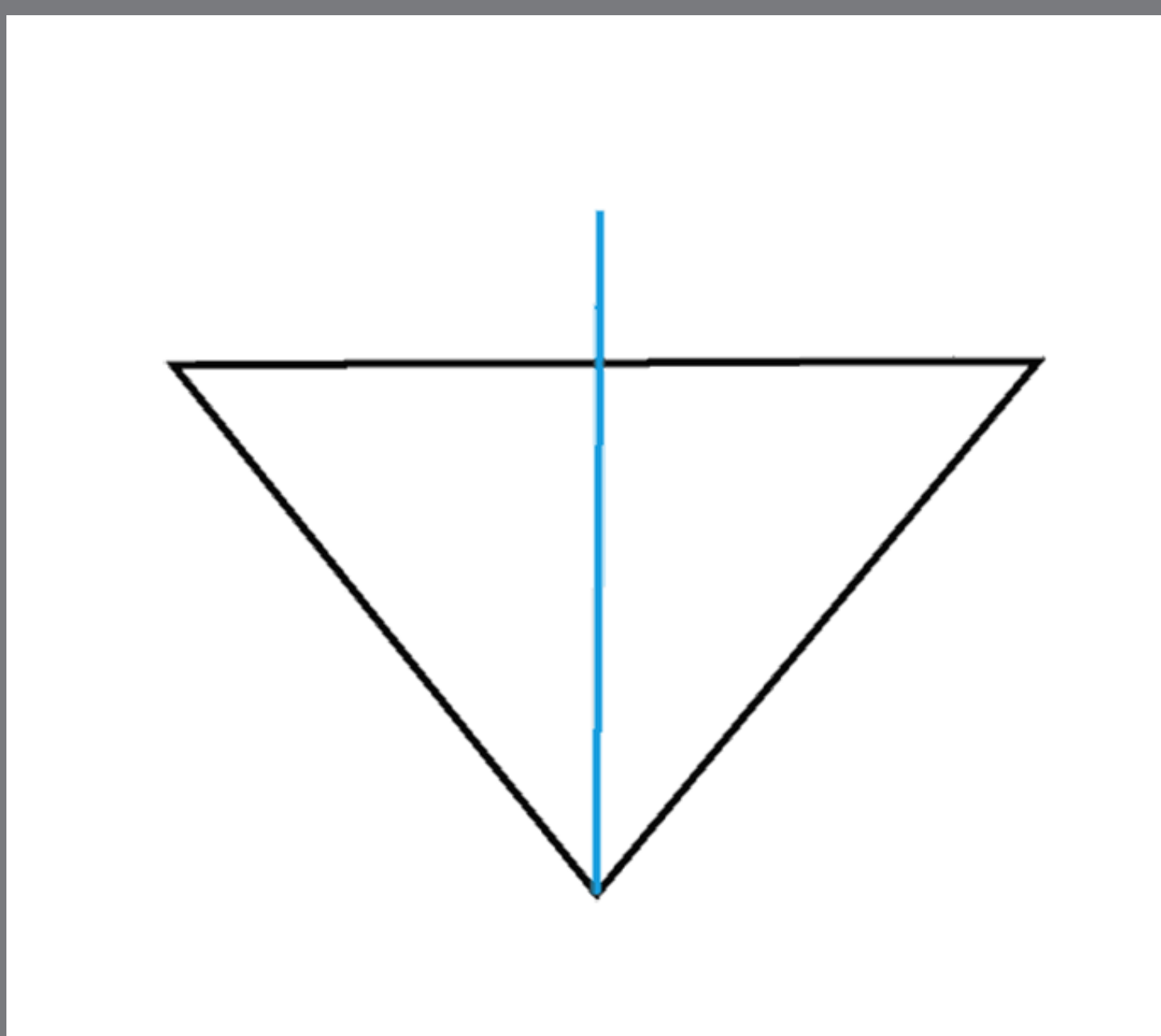
Follow along to draw a compassionate heart!



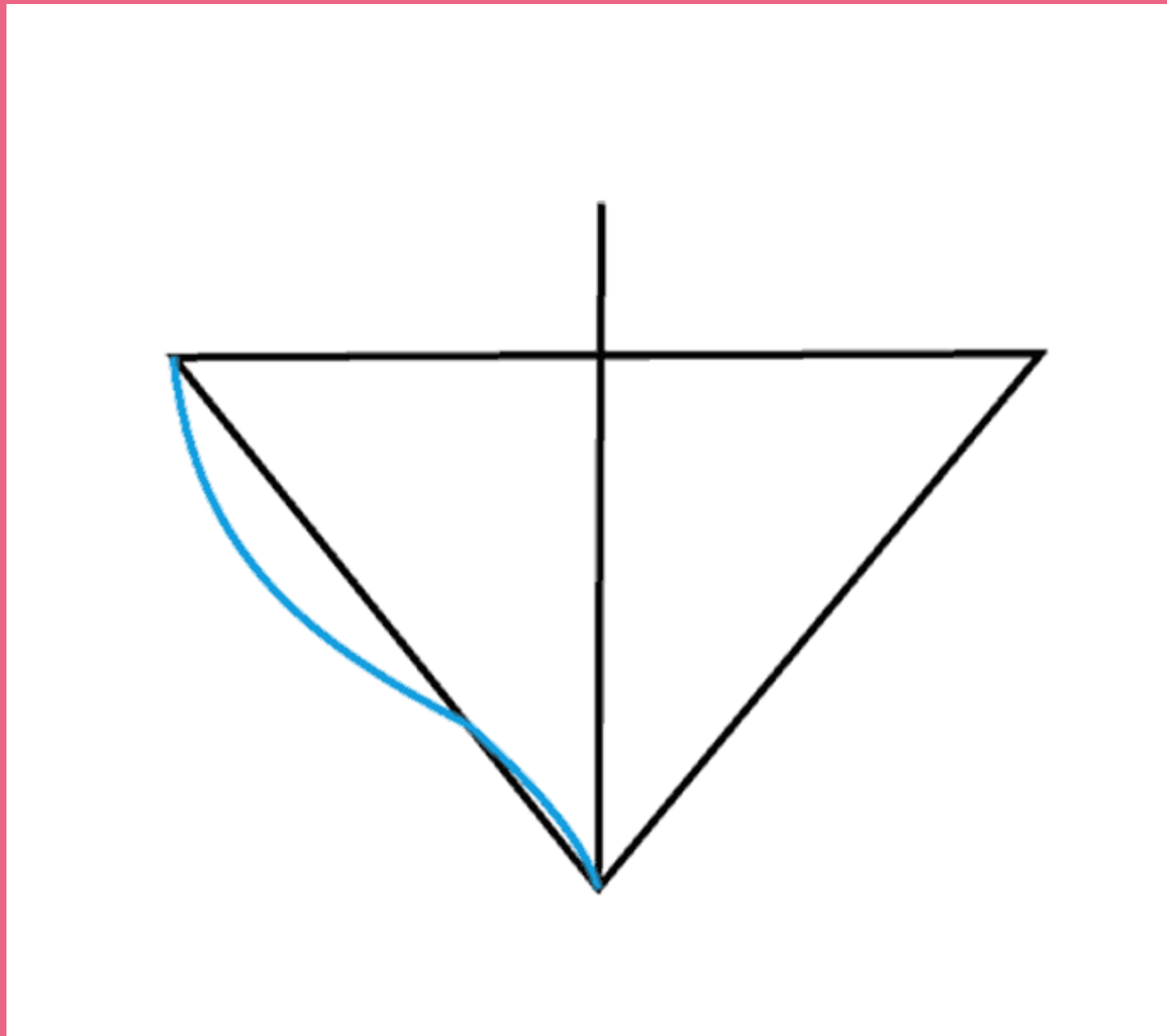
1.Begin by drawing an upside down isosceles triangle - a triangle with two sides of equal length.



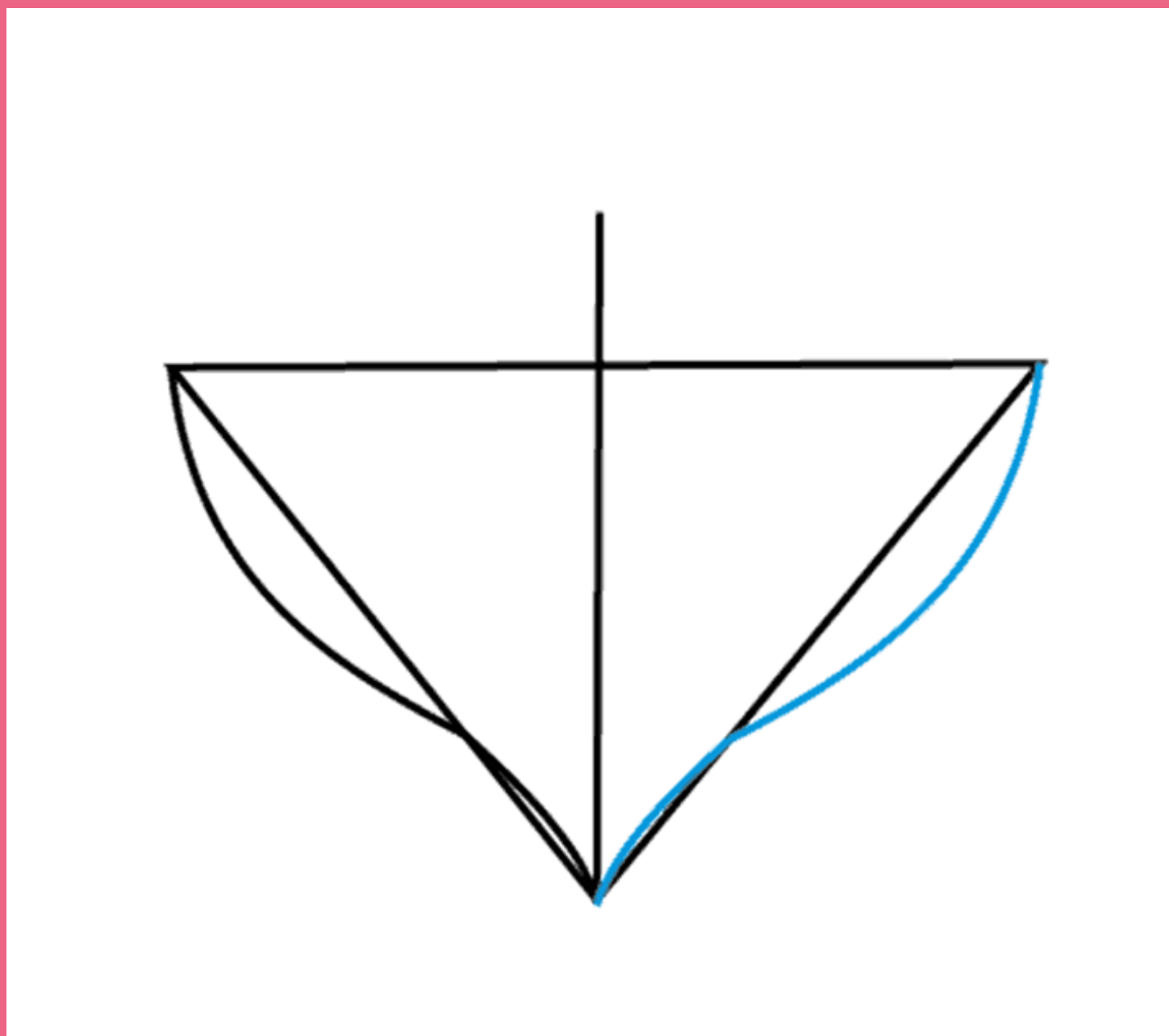
2. Draw a straight vertical line, extending from the bottom point of the triangle, past the top line.



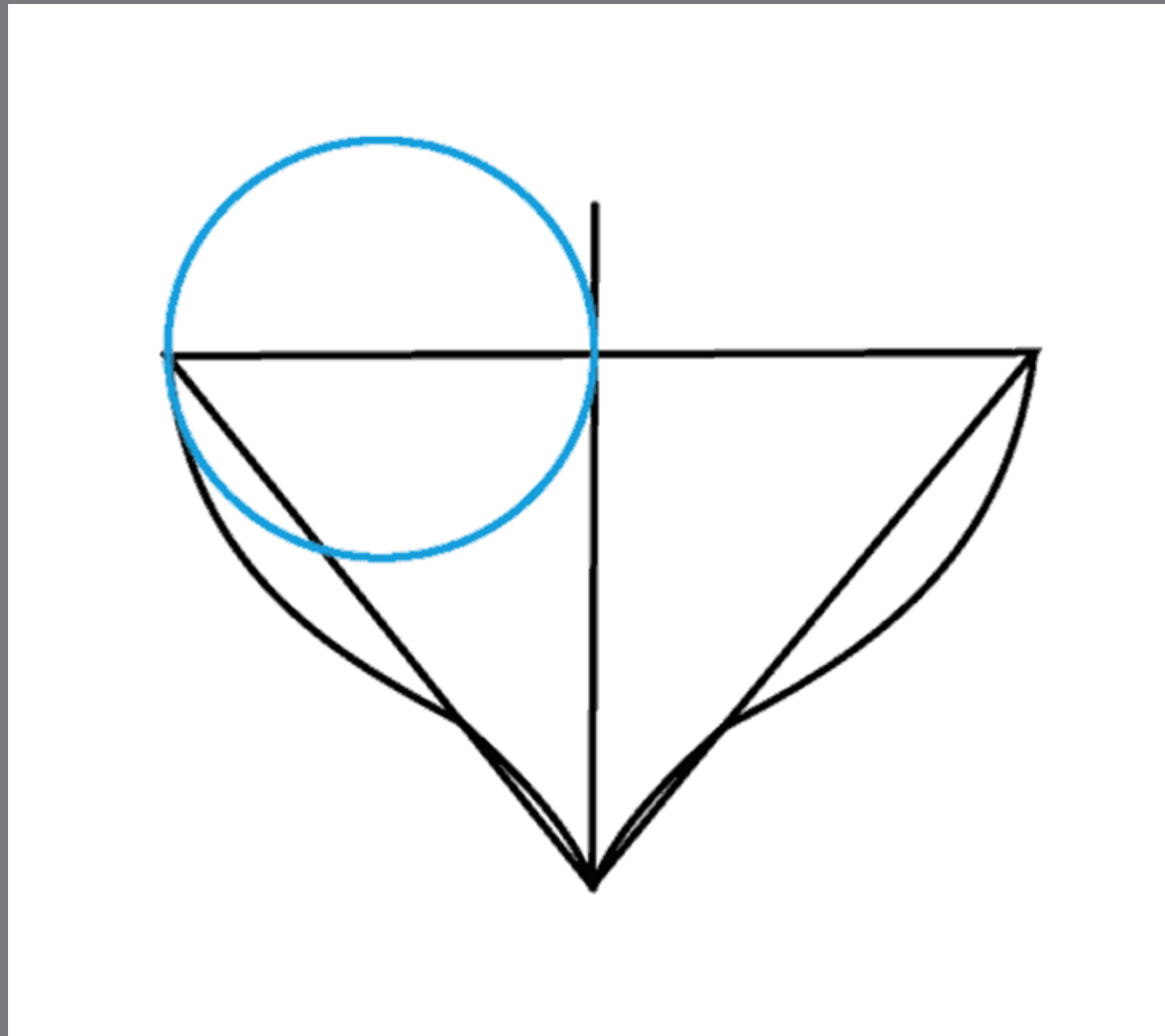
3. Draw a curved line on the left side of the triangle. The line should curve into the triangle near the bottom and outside the triangle near the top.



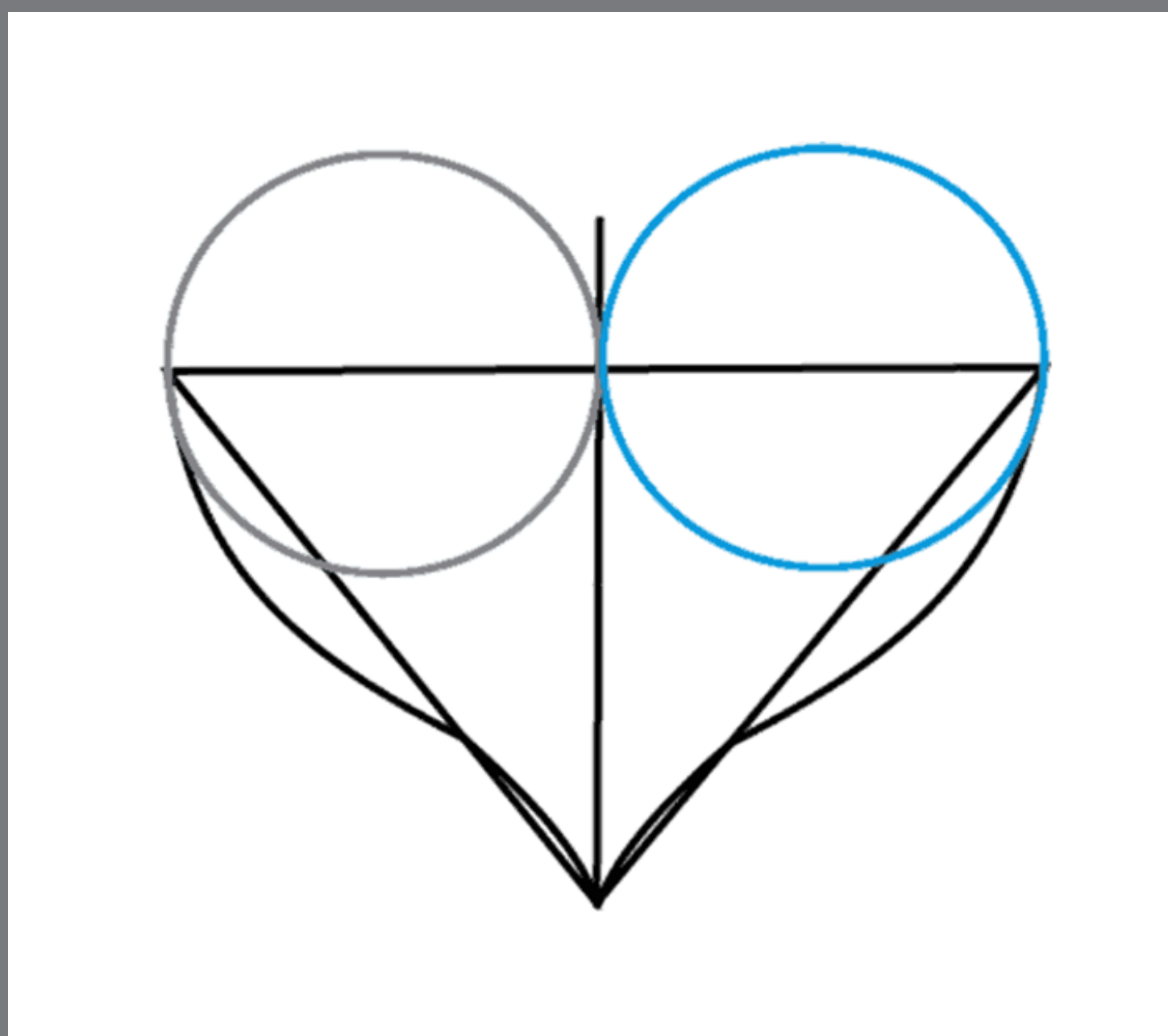
4. Repeat this process to produce a mirror image on the right side.



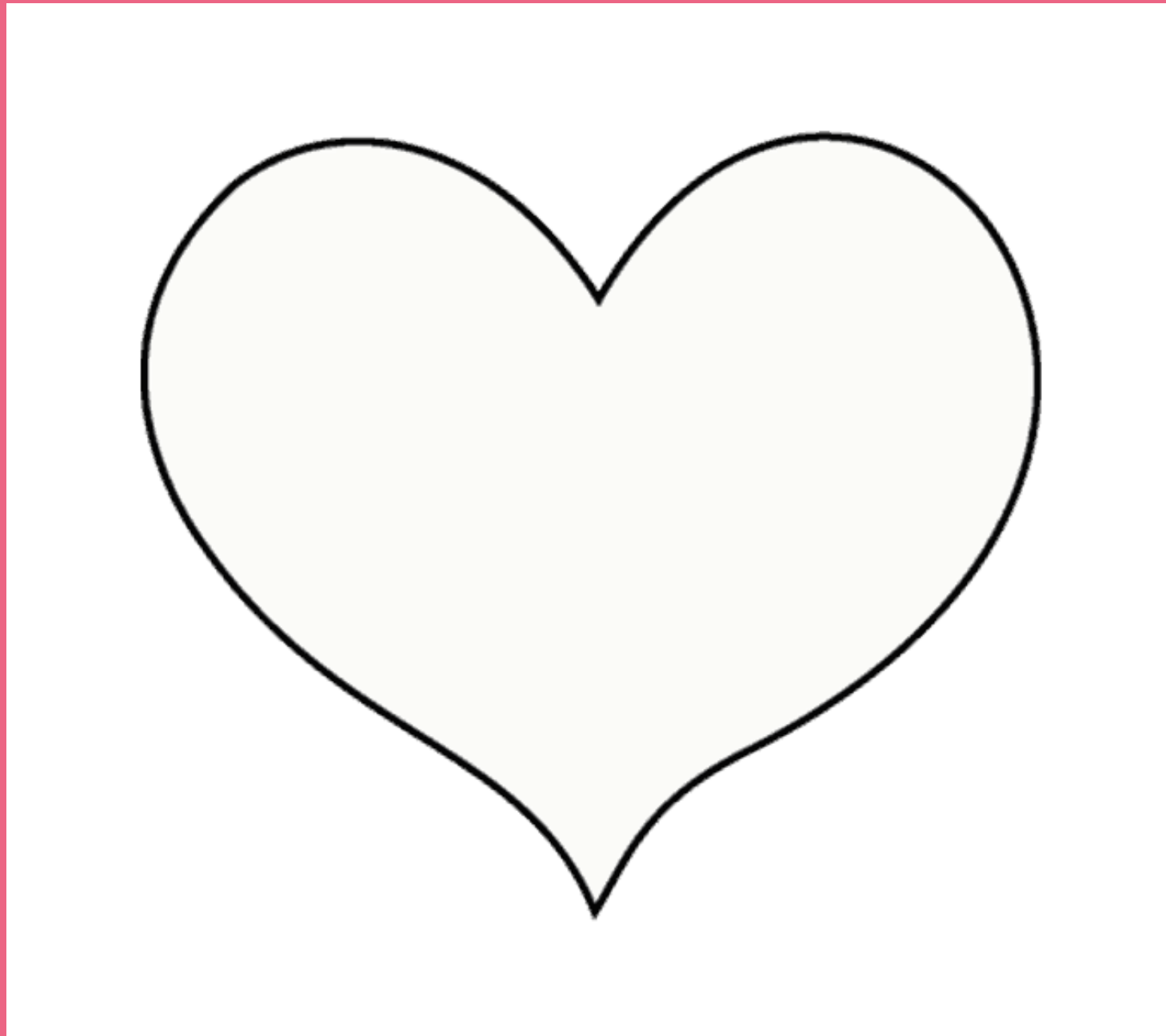
5. Draw a circle intersecting the left side of the triangle. It should be placed between the curved line and the vertical line.



6. Repeat this process to produce a mirror image on the other side.



7. Erase the guide lines from within the shape. You now have a perfectly formed heart.



8. Color your heart. If you want to give the heart depth, draw a wavy line along one side of the heart and a smaller curved line along the top on the opposite side. If you shade these lines in a lighter color than the rest of the heart, it will appear to "shine" as if the image were three-dimensional.
