

# How to Draw a Baby Bear

Difficulty-Intermediate (K-12)

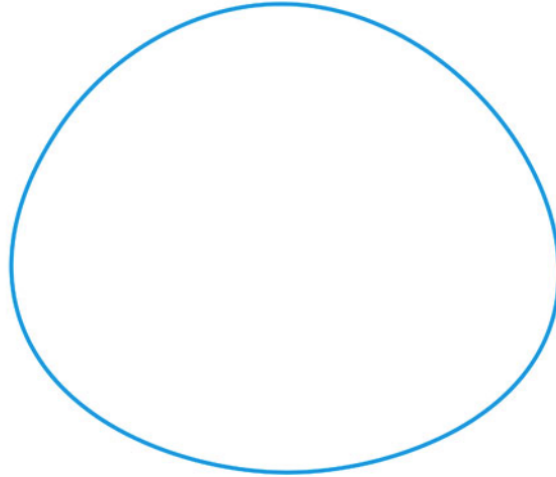
**You will need:**

- Paper
- Something to draw with (pencil, pen, marker, or whatever you'd like!)
- Colored pencils, crayons, or markers to color in your bear



## Step 1

Start by drawing a circle for the bear's head.



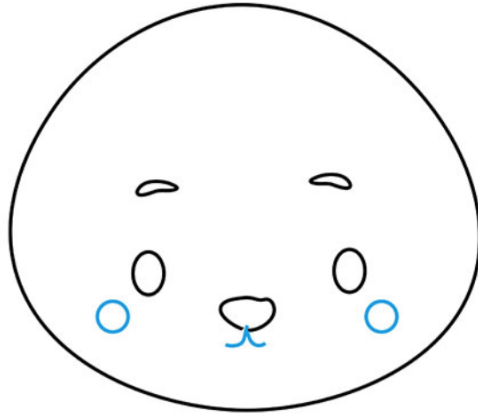
## Step 2

Next, draw the nose towards the bottom of the circle, and then add 2 circles above it for the eyes. Above the eyes, draw 2 small eyebrows.



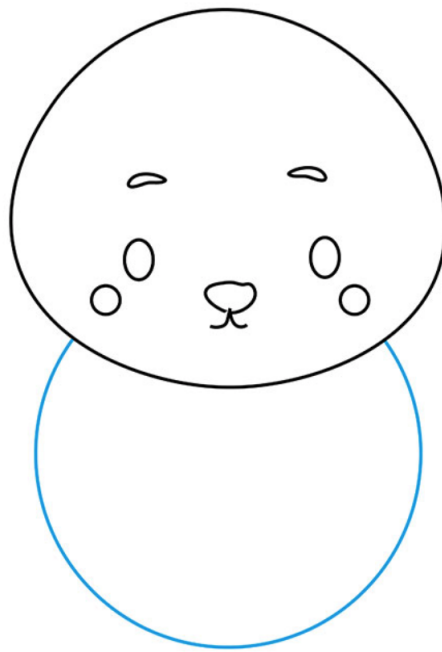
## Step 3

Draw 2 small circles towards the bottom of the head for the cheeks. Under the nose, draw two lines that connect like below.



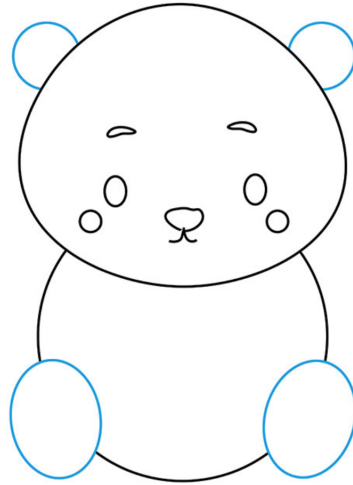
## Step 4

Draw a circle for the body of the bear under the head.



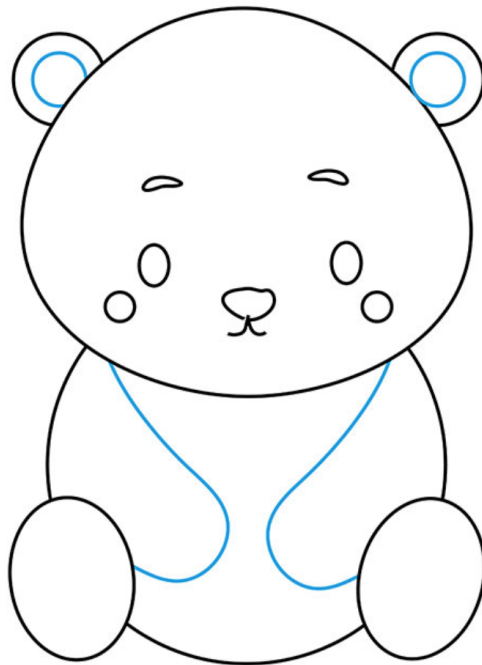
## Step 5

Now draw 2 circles for the bear's ears at the top of its head. Draw 2 ovals at the bottom of the body for the bear's legs.



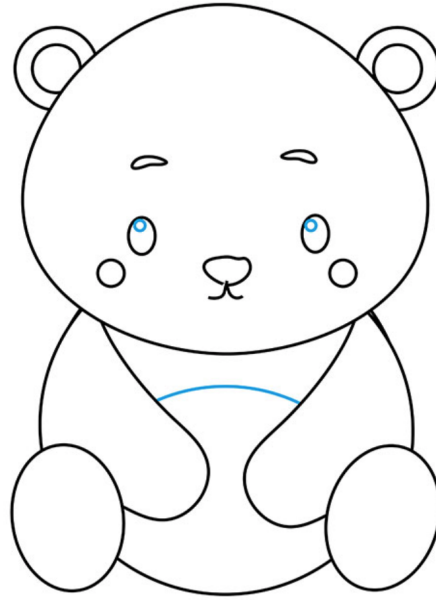
## Step 6

Now let's draw the bear's arms like below. Draw a smaller circle in each of the bear's ears.



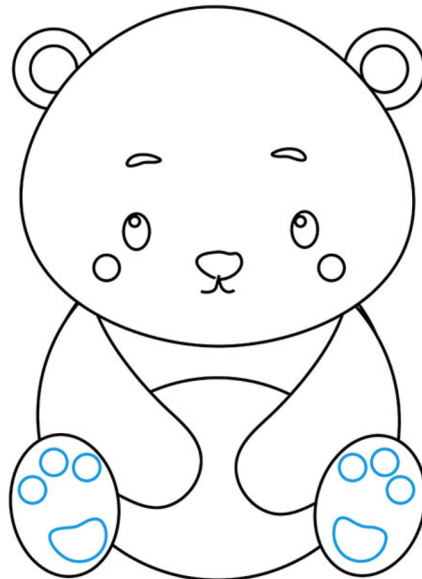
## Step 7

Draw a tiny circle in the top left corner of each eye. For the bear's belly, draw a curved line above the hands.



## Step 8

Next, draw the paws. Draw 3 circles at the top. Underneath those, draw a curved semicircle.



## Step 9

Finally, it's time to color in your bear! Use colors like brown, tan, and black for a natural looking bear. You can use whatever colors you like. Make it a rainbow bear if you wish!
