
How to Draw a Zebra

Difficulty-Beginner (K-12)


You will need:

-Paper

-Something to draw with (pencil, pen, marker, or whatever you'd like!)
-Colored pencils, crayons, or markers to color in your zebra




Start by drawing an oval for the zebra's head. It should look like a chicken egg!




Step 2

Next, below and to the right of the head, draw a circle for the body. It should be more round than the head.




Draw 2 lines connecting the head to the body like this. On top of the head, draw 2 triangles for the ears. At the bottom of the head, draw a curved line.




Step 4


Where we just drew that curved line on the head, we're going to draw 2 dots for the nostrils, and a smile underneath. Next, draw a triangle for the tail. At the end of the triangle, draw a round ponytail shape.



Now draw the zebra's 4 legs. For each leg, draw 2 slightly curved lines and connect them at the bottom. Draw a line towards the bottom for the hooves. Do this 4 times! Then, draw in the zebra's mane on the neck.



Now let's draw the zebra's stripes! You can draw as many as you'd like, but I drew 3.



Time to color in our zebra! Zebras are known for their black and white stripes. Have fun with it!
