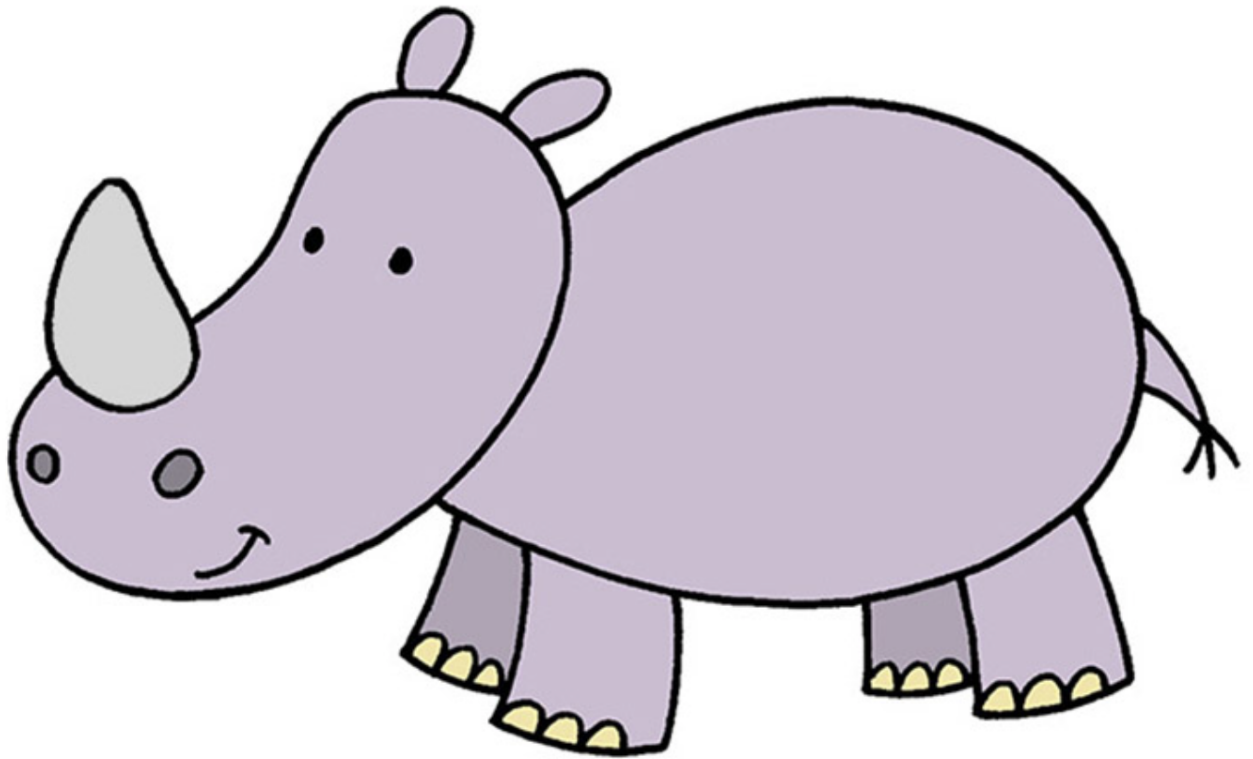


How to Draw a Rhino

Difficulty-Beginner (K-12)

You will need:

- Paper
- Something to draw with (pencil, pen, marker, or whatever you'd like!)
- Colored pencils, crayons, or markers to color in your rhino



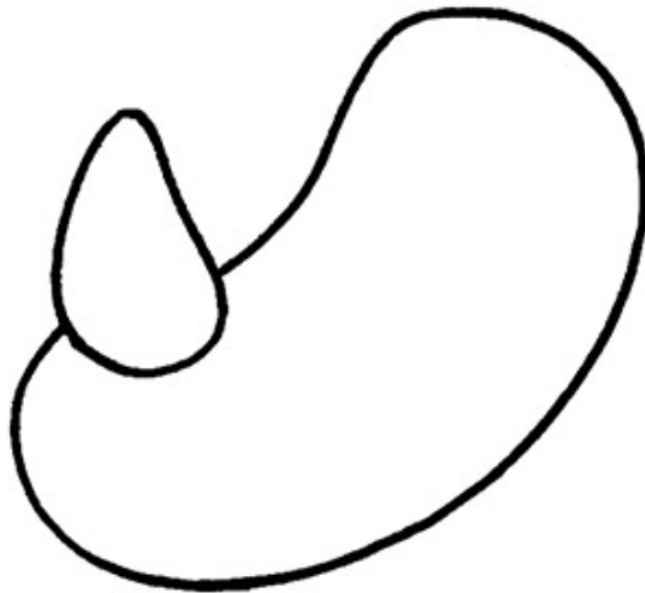
Step 1

Start by drawing the rhino's horn. It should look like a teardrop, like this!



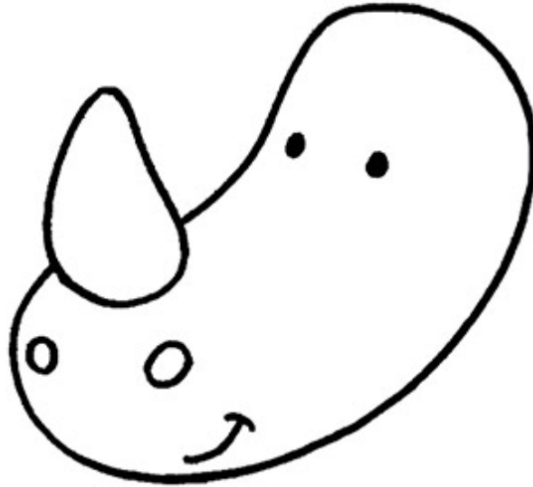
Step 2

Next, draw the rhino's head. It should be in the shape of a bean.



Step 3

Draw the details on the rhino's face. Draw 2 dots for the eyes, and two small circles under the horn for the nose. Give your rhino a little smile.



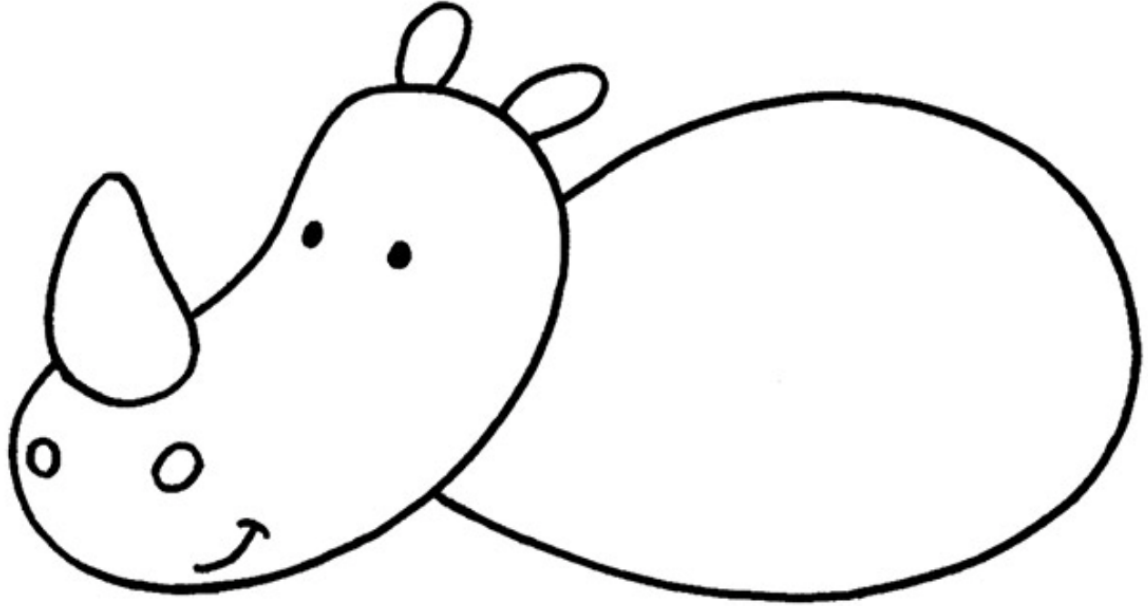
Step 4

Next, draw 2 ovals on the top of the head for the ears.



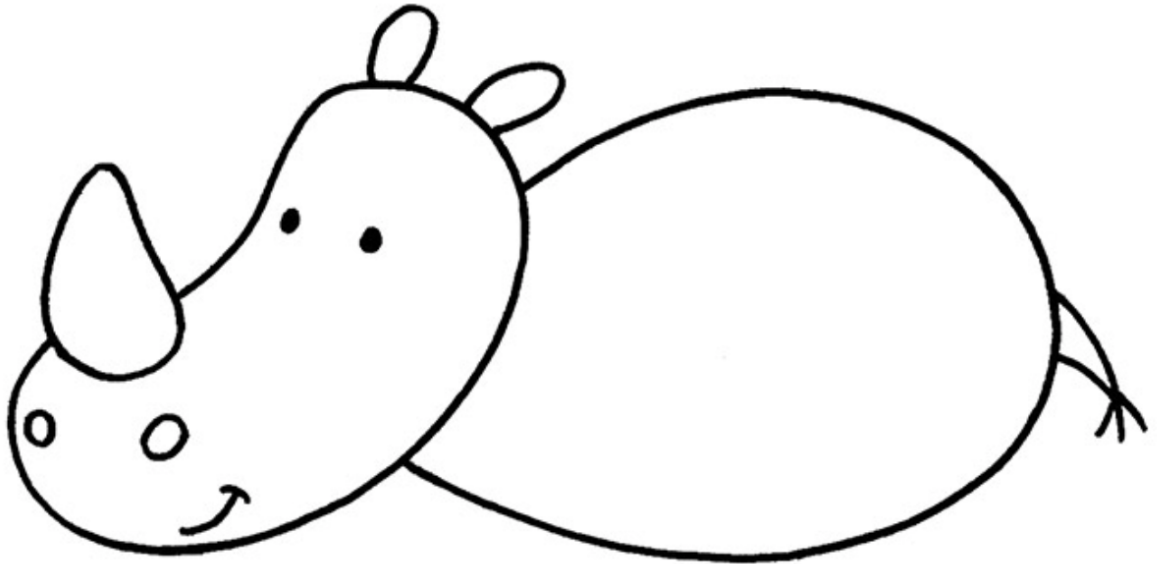
Step 5

Now draw an oval for the rhino's body.



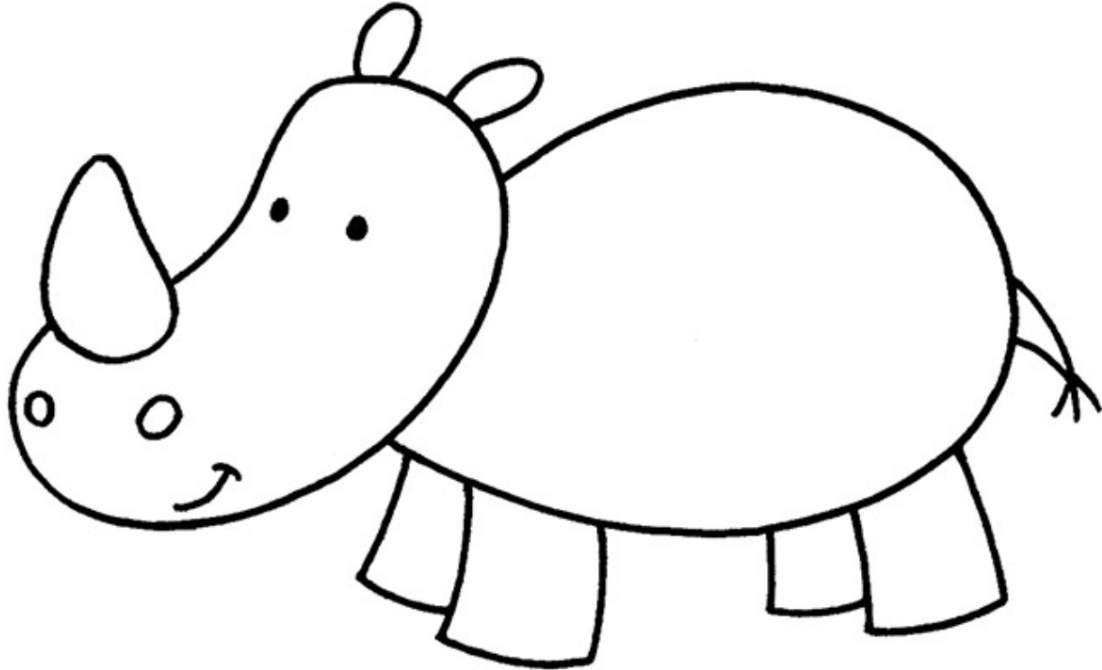
Step 6

Draw the rhino's tail like this. It's a curved triangle with a few lines at the bottom.



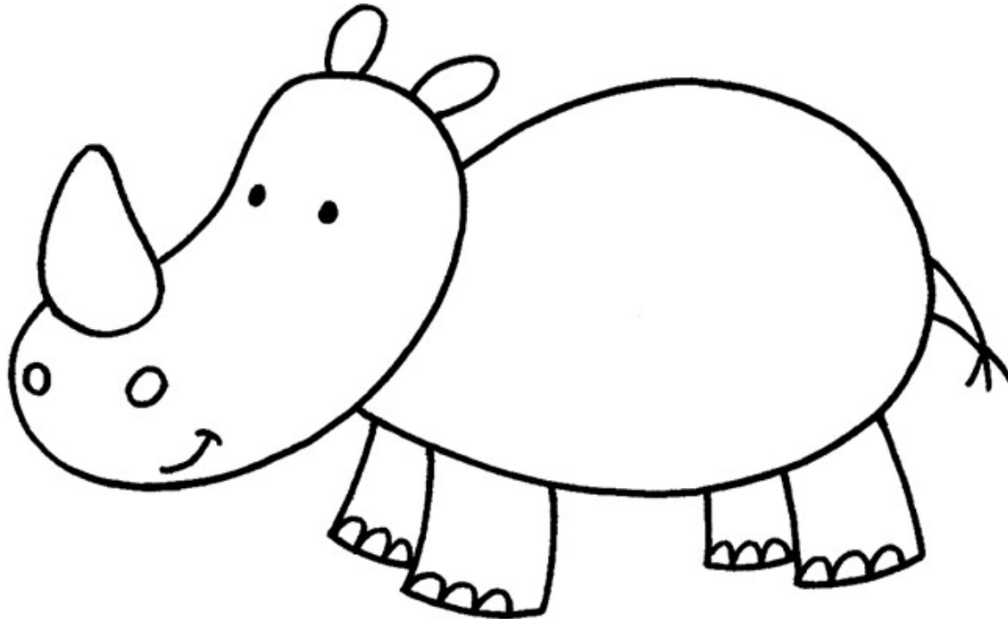
Step 7

Draw 4 rectangles underneath the rhino's body for the legs.



Step 8

Next, draw 3 semicircles on each leg for the rhino's toes.



Step 8

Finally, it's time to color in our rhino! Have fun with it, and give your rhino a name if you wish!
