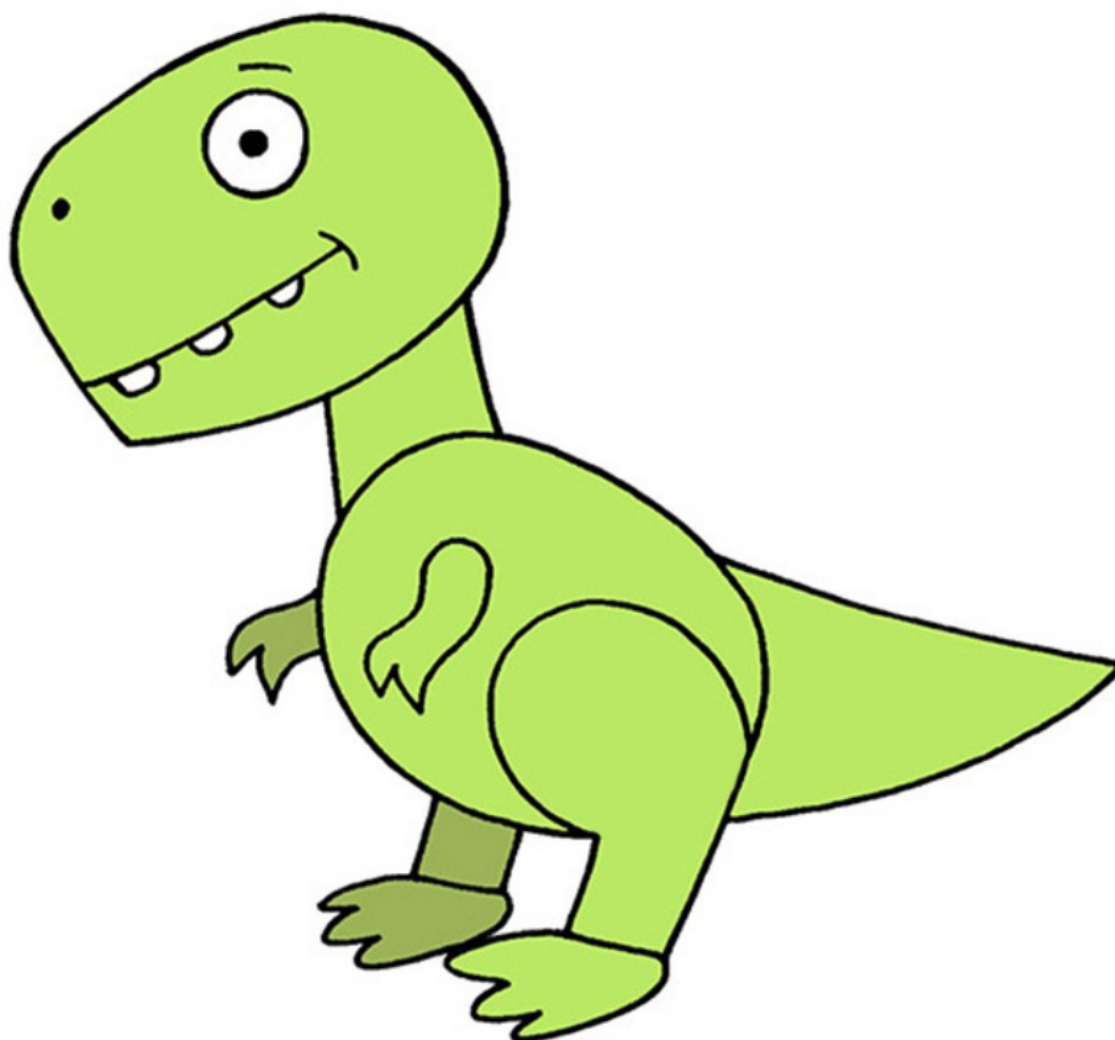


How to Draw a Dinosaur

Difficulty-Intermediate (K-12)

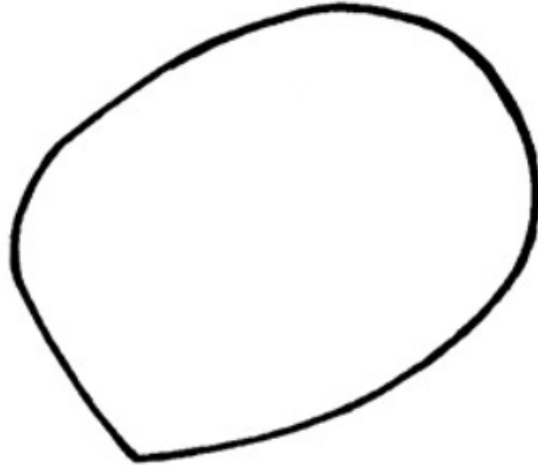
You will need:

- Paper
- Something to draw with (pencil, pen, marker, or whatever you'd like!)
- Colored pencils, crayons, or markers to color in your dinosaur



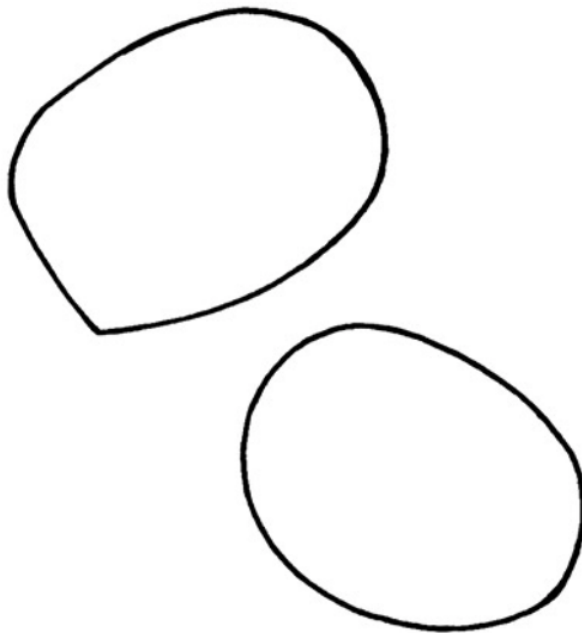
Step 1

Start by drawing the dinosaur's head. Make it an oval like this.



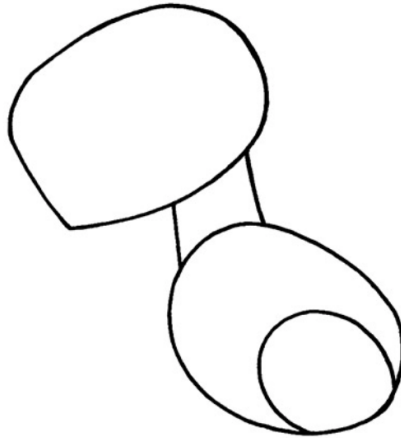
Step 2

To the right and below the head, draw another oval for the body. Make sure it's angled like this.



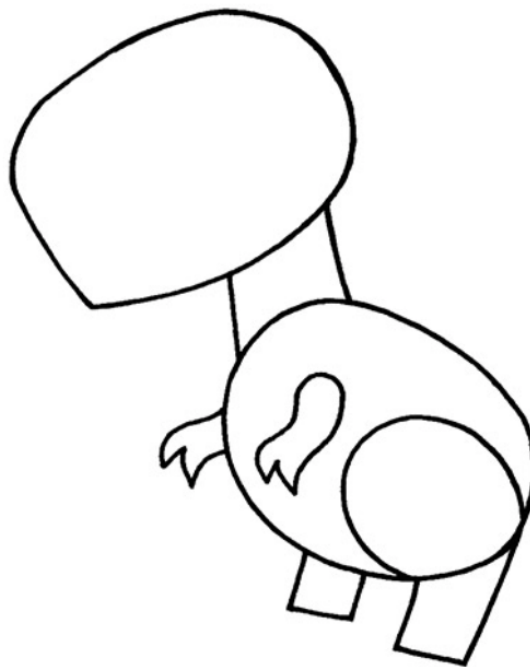
Step 3

Now connect the head and the body using two lines side-by-side. On the bottom right of the body, draw another oval for the dinosaur's thigh.



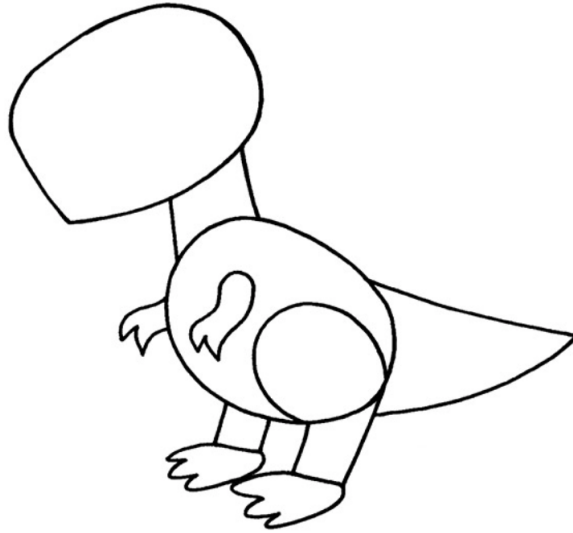
Step 4

Next, draw 2 rectangles at the bottom of the body for the legs. Make sure the thigh and leg are connected! Then, draw the dinosaur's arms like this.



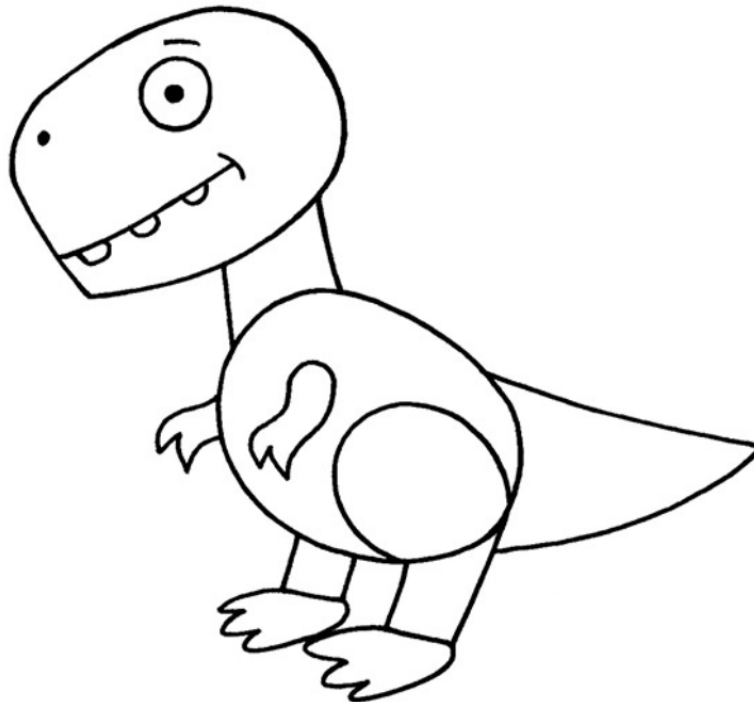
Step 5

Now draw a large triangle for the tail. Under the legs, draw feet like this.



Step 6

Now let's draw the face! Draw a circle with a dot in it for the eye. Above the eye, draw a curved line for the eyebrow. To the left of the eye, draw a dot for the nose. Under the nose, draw a smile with some teeth!



Step 6

Now time for color! Use whatever colors you'd like and remember to have fun with it!
