

Barnyard Symphony



NUMBER OF PLAYERS: 6

PROPS: envelope containing 6 pieces of paper. One says
“Conductor” the others say “Animal”

OBJECT: One player is the musical conductor. The other 5 players are different animals found on a farm (cow, horse, duck, pig, chicken, frog, goose, sheep, etc.). The conductor chooses a song and tells everyone the name.

The conductor then directs the animals accordingly. Each player chooses their animal without telling the others. The conductor begins by pointing at one “animal”. That animal sings using only their animal sound until the conductor adds the next player/animal.

The added “animals” cannot repeat an animal sound that is already being used. The conductor should pick an easy song that everyone in the choir knows.
