

Animal Dance

Things you'll need:

- Small cards with names (and pictures if possible) of different animals.
- Music

Instructions:

This game requires children to use their imagination, and is a lot of fun. You could make note cards (or small cards) with names of different animals written on them, and let every student choose one card.

After doing so, the students have to dance to the music, and move like that animal!

You can also invite them to talk about different characteristics of the animal, like what they eat and how they sound. You can also discuss where they live and anything else you know about them! You can also ask students to imitate their movement- if they move fast or slow, or do they take big steps or small and if they are loud or quiet!
