



CLASSROOM DANCE SCAVENGER HUNT – GRADES K-12



Needed Materials: at least 5 random items (Teacher's choice)

Instructions: This game will not be your traditional scavenger hunt where everyone sporadically runs around to find a list of items hidden throughout a particular space. The students will have to execute certain dance moves as they are looking for the item.

Assuming this activity will be done in a classroom, the instructor must hide a list of items (items of their choosing) when the students are not in the room (to prevent temptation to look from those Cheater McGees out there, lol). Write the list of dance moves and review those moves with the students. Print or write out on the board the list of hidden items for the students to refer too. Then the students will be split into teams of three or four, depending on how many students and items you have. Then, one to two items and a dance move will be called out, and one student from each team will go to find the item(s) while doing the dance move.

Once the item is found, the students will go back to their teams. For the next item, different students and a different move will be called. Keep this pattern until all items are found and whichever team has the most items wins.

List of moves

1. Skip
2. Slow motion
3. Jump
4. Sliding or skating
5. Chasse (how to do a chasse- <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=HjOd-2g508k>)
6. Step touch (how to do a step touch- https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=wH9hsR7Ck_M)
7. Leap
8. Walking in a zig zag
